Commando units planned

MIN of the Lancaster Builders will soon be moving back for troops and military commando units who will move into the hills during the coming week. This is one of the new defensive measures being put into effect following the quadruple murder at the 'K' farm on Saturday night.

WITH 'I' FORCE IN THE FORESTS OF THE ABERDARES

By W. David

A RELATIVELY small force, staffed by the Colony's own young proving the best answer so far discovered to the problem of dealing with the Mau Mau gangs, estimated to number some hundreds of men, which lurk in the dense Aberdare forests.

'I' Force operates under police control but practically all its with them are occasional volunteers from the Kenya Police Reserve, who come up when they can to help.

As shown in these pictures, 'I' Force operates on the principle of forming fast-moving, completely independent patrols to probe the forests, constantly harrying the Mau Mau gangs. Working live rough under very trying conditions.

Operating with the Kiangaris are some 60 Turkana and Elgeyo Wanduri trackers. Last week a 100-strong force of Masai found long, patient patrols and ambushes in thick undergrowth, without spectacular results too uninteresting.

'I' Force is now five weeks old, having been formed in the last part of December under the command of Captain Neville

Cooper, who is an Elburgon farmer and had wartime experience in the Burma jungles.

He has organised his force into three patrols, under Messrs E. D. P. Harley (who farms on the slopes of Aberdare), John Bamber and M. Cooke, both from the Rift Valley. Each patrol is divided into three separate operating units.

The force lives on the farm of Mr. J. L. Squair, the well-known Ngaiti farmer whose home was smashed by a Mau Mau raiding party in November. Here, on the rolling grandmoor of a spur of the Aberdare, with a 100-mile view to Mount Kenya and beyond, 'I' Force has established itself round the farm manager's house. Nearby, an airstrip has been marked out with white-painted logs of wood, at a height of over 7,000 feet.

From their headquarters, the patrols move out day and night to cover the fringes of the Aberdare—watching for the movements of sympathisers or gangs coming in search of food—and also probing far into the forests itself in the hope of making contact.

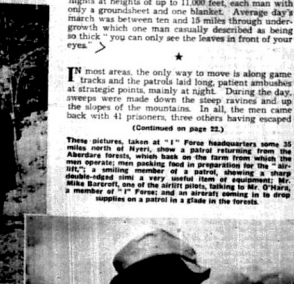
The Force mounted its first large-scale offensive during "Operation Longstop", completed last week, during which 100 square miles of forest were swept for Mau Mau hideouts.

For this, the "I" patrols spent five days and nights at heights of up to 11,000 feet, each man with only a groundsheet and one blanket. Average day's march was between ten and 15 miles through undergrowth which one man casually described as being so thick "you can only see the leaves in front of your eyes."

In most areas, the only way to move is along game tracks and the patrols laid long, patient ambushes at strategic points, mainly at night. During the day, sweeps were made down the steep ravines and up the slopes of the mountains. In all, the men came back with 41 prisoners, three others having escaped.
