New French Consul for East Africa

Three minutes in court

"Statute," New Standard
ONLY 11 days after the murder of Mr. and Mrs. Roger Ruck at their home in the North Kikuyu, 13 Kikuyus yesterday made a three-minute appearance before Native Magistrate Peter Steenkamp, who is in charge of the Kikuyu border. Peter Steenkamp told the court that all 13 accused were members of the same gang, headed by Mr. Ruck only. He asked that they should be charged with the killing of Nakuru Prisoner for a fortnight.

Mr. Clegg granted the application. All the accused were either dark grey or dark brown blankets. They had been going on the court, but were not allowed to leave it until the court orders calling them back.

Twelve of the accused were employed by Mr. Ruck and his wife, and the remaining one by the neighbouring farm of Mr. John Colville.

It is understood that in this case the accused were Kikuyus. Africans accused in connection with the killing will be given the services of the Emergency Welfare Council which will be available to the Supreme Court without the need for certification.




