Commonwealth in Coronation oath

INCLUDED FOR FIRST TIME

COUNTRIES of the British Commonwealth will be named specifically for the first time in the oath which Queen Elizabeth will take at her Coronation on June 2. It is announced. The Archbishop of Canterbury, Geoffrey Fisher, said the first part of the oath will be worded as follows: "Will you solemnly promise and swear to defend with all your might and power, as you shall be able, the United Kingdom of Great Britain, Northern Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, the Union of South Africa, Pakistan and Ceylon, and those other States which at the time of the coming into being of the said Commonwealth shall have become united to them?"

SO far the Americans are succeeding beyond all expectations in replacing their inflationary boom by a depression. With the growing import of goods from other countries occasional soft spots, and there are always some unexpected dangers. But several are surprisingly favourable.

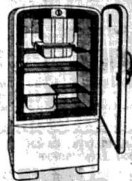

Dr. Chesser was the originator of the "shock" treatment, which he has used on a number of criminals. He has found that it is more effective than long sentences, and that it is more humane than corporal punishment.

AN ARTIST PAINTS THE KENYA SCENE FOR THE RHODES CENTENARY EXHIBITION

By Jane Irving

The pictures you see on this page are photographs of oil paintings by Mr. R. McCallum Sim, Art Master of the Prince of Wales School, who was commissioned to paint seven pictures showing the main products of Kenya for the Agricultural Stand at the Rhodes Centenary Exhibition at Hala-Bora.

Confronted with seven subjects to portray—wheat, sisal, Arabid coffee, sisal, sorghum, coffee and Boran cattle—the artist was given a completely free hand except for two main points of view and to show in every case European and African working together.

Immediately word broke up for the Christmas holidays, Mr. McCallum Sim started out on his painting subject which took him to the farms of Kenya. He did not take the usual camera, but slightly abbreviated his camera, but a single lens which Mr. McCallum Sim uses, removes the glossy finish which makes most oil paintings difficult to when light strikes them at the wrong angle.

With a camera without coloring set beneath seven different kinds of Kenya things and the whole washed in permanent magenta, these paintings are outstanding in their brightness in Africa.

So impressed with them was Major F. W. Cavendish-Bentinck, that he took all seven to Government House for the Evrying Bureau to see. Mr. McCallum Sim had been asked by the Chief Secretary to paint the pictures for the Centenary of the new B.I. ship, the S.S. Kenya, later on this year.

Before he could start on his exhibition subjects, Mr. McCallum Sim had to spend some time on research, especially studying the best pieces of cattle such as the painting of the number of ears and horns. He gathered information from many sources, including the Abattar, films from the Government laboratory and the Coffee Board. Most of the figures are almost identical every year.

And over a brief description of each painting as it was given to me by the artist.

The wheat-growing areas are shown in the picture in the centre of the stand. It shows the European and African working together in the fields and following the main composition was chosen in with colored film. Like all other pictures painted directly with the brush.

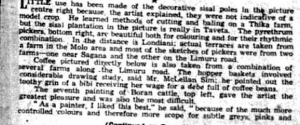
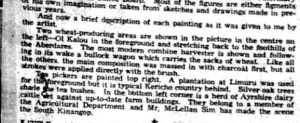
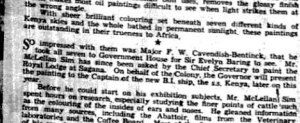
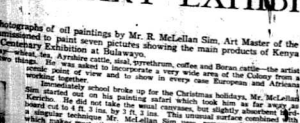
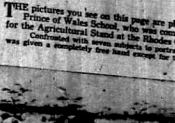
The picture in the top right is a plantation at Limuru was used for the tea bushes. In the bottom left corner is a herd of Arabid cattle, the Agricultural Department and Mr. McCallum Sim has made the scene of the South Kenyan.

THE pictures you see on this page are photographs of oil paintings by Mr. R. McLellan Sim, Art Master of the Prince of Wales School, who was commissioned to paint seven pictures showing the main products of Kenya for the Agricultural Show at the Rhodes Centenary Exhibition at Salisbury.

Confined with seven subjects to paint—wheat, Arabians, cattle, deal, pyrethrum, coffee and bananas—was given a remarkably free hand except for the two things. He was asked to incorporate a very wide range of Kenyan produce, and to show in every case European and African working together.

Immediately about lunch for the Christmas holidays, Mr. McLellan Sim started on his painting and which took him as far away as a picture substance Mr. McLellan Sim.

LITTLE use has been made of the decorative steel poles in the picture in the center right because the artist retained the steel and timber for a model crop. He learned methods of cutting and binding on a Thika farm, but the steel plantations in the picture is really in Thika. The pyrethrum pickers, bottom right, are beautiful both for coloring and for their rhythmic composition. In the distance is a coffee plantation.

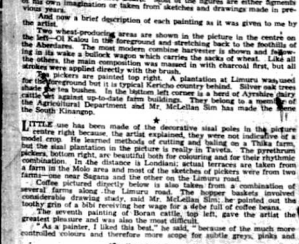
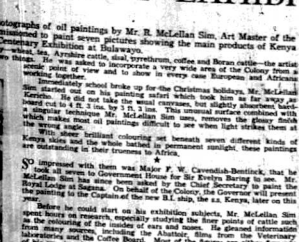
The pictures in the Middle area and most of the sketches of pictures were from two farms—one near Sigaya and the other on the Lamuru.
