EMPLOYERS SEEK MORE PRODUCTIVITY

Costs rise in N. Rhodesia

THERE was a surplus of labour in Northern Rhodesia during 1955 and the majority of employers had sufficient for their needs, according to the Department of Labour's annual report. Skilled European workers, however, found no difficulty in employment but accommodation—particularly for married people—was difficult to obtain.

At the year 1954-55 African registered for employment compared with 8,229 the previous year and 6,288 in 1953. The Department placed 5,207 Africans in employment compared with 4,215 in 1954.

There was evidence, the report said, that the steady increase in wage rates and housing costs were forcing employers to try to obtain more work from individual employees.

Housing problem

"It would seem that by better management and supervision many concerns could overcome rising labour productivity considerably while at the same time increasing the productivity and wages of those whom they employ," the report states. "The largest wage mills in the territory African labour does not work from 1.10m to 1.20m worth of production."

The shortage of housing both for European and African has become a serious problem in many towns—so, in fact, getting a house in a town was more difficult than in the European country for the job.

There is a copper mine which strikes early in 1956, but reports of a strike in the copper labour pool and on-going work that was often done.

In April, the number in the labour force stood at 14,818 but in the year 1955 had risen to 15,271 and of their own accord, 1,071 were unemployed.

Many unemployed Africans preferred to work in the mines under the unbrake chance of a job in the mines rather than work with a mining or construction contractor.

Worked well

Without a satisfactory register system in control of labour it is impossible to know how many Africans were employed on the Copperbelt. It is believed that on Copperbelt both the big and small contractors have good employment records.

AT the end of 1955 there were nine European, two Asian and 14 African trade unions in existence according to the Northern Rhodesia Department of Labour for 1955.

Rise in Northern Rhodesian African welfare grants

GrANTS to local authorities for their African welfare services rose to £28,811 in 1955, an increase of £1,100,000 on the previous financial year.

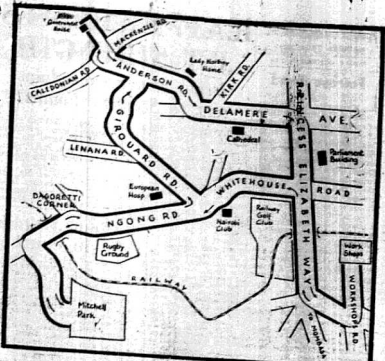

LATIN AMERICA BIG POTENTIAL MARKET FOR BRITISH FILMS

THE British film industry is making plans to launch a frontal attack on the Latin American market with the film **The Battle of the River Plate**. It hopes that this ambitious and authentic version of one of the most dramatic naval engagements of World War II, remembered by so many Uruguayans and Argentines, will give its commercial venture a good start and help to open the door for British films.

Latin America has long been a potential market for British films. Most Latin American like them, and most town dwellers in this part of the world are film fans in every sense of the word.

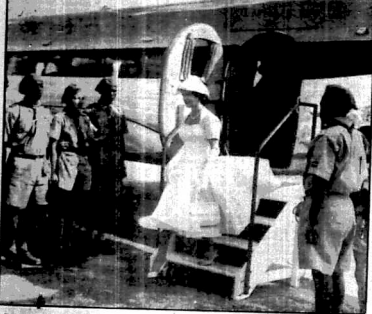
