Considerable increases in the flow of capital into Kenya for investment in commercial enterprises are reported in the annual report of the Secretary-General's Department which was submitted this week to Kenya's Legislative Council. The report records that 252 companies were registered in 1956, an increase of 109 on the previous year.

The total capital of new companies registered in 1956 was estimated at £1,125,000, an increase of £240,000 on the figure for 1955.

At the end of 1956, a total of 2,826 public and private companies were incorporated in Kenya, compared with 2,616 at the end of 1954.

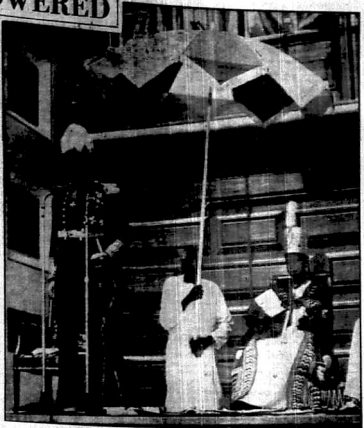



QUESTION that crops up more and more frequently is: Can the Colony any longer afford to pay the bill for overseas leave for civil servants? Leave the war, many folks have become much more travel-conscious and spend their time on the Continent and even in the States, and so people in Britain often spend their leave in South Africa or Thailand, so the money goes out of Kenya after all."
