WORK began yesterday on clearing the blocked Suez Canal. The United Nations officials in charge of the operation, Lt-Gen. Wheeler, said the Egyptian Government had agreed that the U.N. salvage fleet should start clearance work immediately at Suez.

Gen. Wheeler said he had signed contracts for two British, one French and four German salvage ships to begin work. Other salvage vessels from Denmark, Holland, Norway and Sweden are expected to arrive at Port Said on January 11.

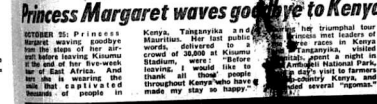

## INCREASE IN WHEAT TRADE

WORLD exports of wheat and wheat flour increased in the 1956-57 marketing year, according to a Food and Agriculture Organization report.

In that year they totalled 78,000,000 tons of wheat and wheat flour (expressed in flour equivalent), and were 2,000,000 tons higher than the previous season's equivalent.

The top exporters of wheat and wheat flour in the 1956-57 marketing year were the U.S.A. with 20,000,000 tons, compared with 17,000,000 in 1955-56.

Canadian exports The greatest increases in wheat exports were in Canada, the U.S.A. and South America. The U.S.A. exported 17,000,000 tons, up from 15,000,000 in 1955-56. Canadian exports were 2,000,000 tons higher than the previous season's equivalent.

Canadian shipments increased 1,000,000 tons to 2,000,000 tons, with the rise mainly in wheat. U.S.A. exports were 2,000,000 tons higher than the previous season's equivalent.

Western Germany responded during the 1956-57 season as a relatively important importer of wheat. It imported 1,000,000 tons, up from 800,000 in 1955-56.

EGYPTIANS CLEAR ISMAILIA HARBOUR OF WRECKS First U.N. task at Port Said ends AGREEMENT SIGNED

ISMAILIA harbour has been completely cleared of wrecks. The last ship was raised by Egyptian salvagers. Meanwhile, the first United Nations salvage operation has been completed. The U.N. teams, with the Dutch salvage ship Arno and the French salvage vessel Dunkirk, raised the scuttled tug Ardent, sunk in front of the former Canal Company's headquarters by the Egyptians two months ago.

Two German salvage ships are continuing work on the El Redha bridge. One expert said yesterday: "It is not the easy job we thought at first. The bridge was not simply collapsed into the canal - it was blown up, and parts of it are twisted together. Divers are to be sent down with oxy-acetylene torches to cut away the twisted parts."

Israel's aims 'achieved' It was reported yesterday that the agreement between Egypt and the United Nations on clearing the canal had been signed in Cairo. The agreement allows the U.N. fleet, under the command of Lt.-Gen. Wheeler, to reopen the waterway.

In Jerusalem yesterday the Israeli Prime Minister, Mr. Ben-Gurion, said it was possible that Israel had now attained a military truce for several years. Israel, he said, had these three aims she had set herself in the Sinai operation.

These were the ejection of Egyptians from the Gaza Strip, the smothering of Egyptian forces in Sinai, and the reopening of the Egyptian-blockaded Gulf of Aqaba to shipping. Mr. Ben-Gurion was speaking an Israeli fleet arrived at Elath, Israel's port at the head of the Gulf of Aqaba, after sailing round the Cape.
