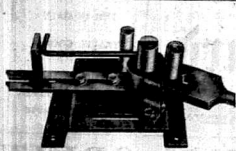

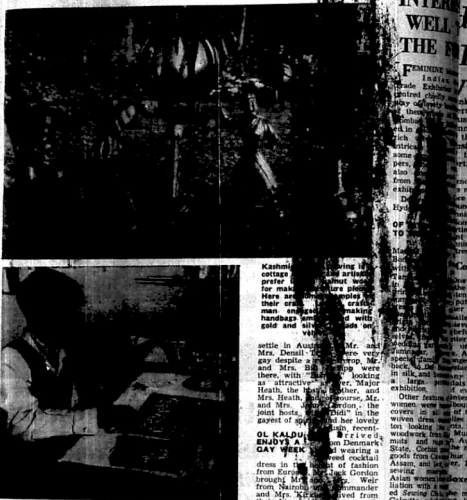

New Cabinet to be announced soon WHITEHALL ACTIVITY

SIR ANTHONY EDEN has resigned his seat in Parliament, it was announced yesterday in London. In a letter to his constituency, Warwick and Leamington, he said he had not the strength for the strenuous life of a Member and added: "I have no doubt where my duty lies."

It was learned from official sources that Sir Anthony had been offered a seat by the Queen. An announcement issued at Buckingham Palace stated that the Queen would return to London from Sandringham on Monday. The Prime Minister, Mr. Macmillan, is then expected to submit his list of Ministers for Royal approval. It is believed that the new Government are likely to be announced tomorrow night or on Monday.

Yesterday was a day of great activity in Downing Street. The business of choosing a Cabinet began with a summons from Mr. Macmillan to the President of the Board of Trade, Mr. Thorncroft, who has been mentioned as a possible Chancellor of the Exchequer. The Minister of State, Mr. Heathcoat-Amory, was the next visitor. Agriculture, the Foreign Secretary, Mr. Selwyn Lloyd, and the Prime Minister, Mr. Macmillan, were seen afterwards by the Foreign Secretary.

Speculation in the Press on Monday for the office of Lord Secretary included those of Mr. Butler, the Colonial Secretary, Mr. Leanos-Bones, and the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Mr. Duncan Sandys, who is a non-voter of Sir Winston Churchill.

BILL FOR WAGES IN COLONY SOARS

KENYA'S estimated wage bill in 1957 is £27,100,000, more than four times the total in 1946.

Workers' private industry received the largest share, £12,000,000, while the public services accounted for £7,000,000 and agriculture £5,000,000.

These figures are given in the report issued by the East African Statistical Department. They include a valuation of salaries and free boards when supplied by employers, and employee contributions towards housing rates.

The calculations have been based on gross earnings before deductions for taxes.

Average earnings in 1946 were £2,700,000, compared with £27,100,000 for Africans and £13,100,000 for Asians. The total wage bill in Nairobi, Mombasa and Kisumu is estimated at £4,100,000.

The reported average for industry and commerce is £1,200 in Kenya and £1,200 in Uganda. The average for agriculture is £1,200. The average for European workers was £341, £385 and £491.

Asian men and women earned £604 and £235 respectively in private industry; £535 and £195 in agriculture; and £504 and £201 in agriculture. The corresponding figures for European workers were £1,200 and £491.

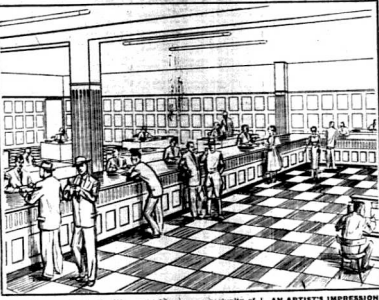

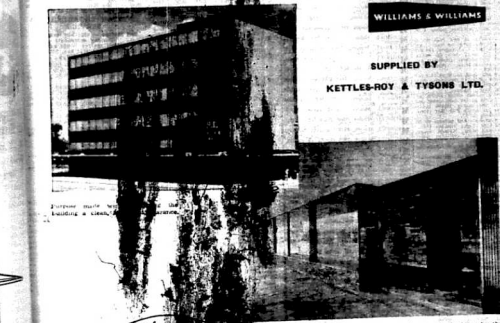

MOTION BEFORE BUNDESTAG

THE West German Bundestag (Lower House) has referred to committee a motion to sell to private hands the vast Volkswagen works.

The motion asks the Government to prepare a Bill to sell the works for £23,000,000, the names of £2 to £23 to be paid by instalments.

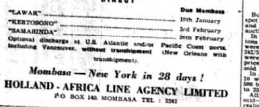
