## ROUTE TO BY-PASS THE SUEZ

### Goods transhipment across Israel

### SAVING ON CAPE RUN

ISRAEL has completed the first stage of its plan to save goods from Europe to Africa and the Far East by an alternative route to the blocked Suez Canal.

The goods will be taken overland from the Mediterranean Port of Haifa to Elath, on the Gulf of Akaba. Elath was opened to Israeli shipping for the first time for years in November, when Israeli forces advancing through Sinai broke Egyptian gun blockade.

British shipping companies reported that the first consignment destined to be shipped over this route—100 tons of tin—left the Cape route, had arrived at Haifa, and was on its way to Elath.

#### 'ENOUGH FOR NEEDS'

FINANCIAL aid sufficient to meet Kenya's requirements "on a reasonable basis" during the next fiscal year has been promised by the British Treasury, the Minister for Finance, Mr. Vasey, disclosed yesterday.

Mr. Vasey, who had just returned to Nairobi after 24 days of financial talks in London, told the East African Standard that at the present stage he could not reveal the extent of assistance promised by the British Treasury.

He said: "It is my first duty to make a report to the Government. I hope it will be possible for me to make an official statement next week." Mr. Vasey also said he felt his mission had been a success, added: "Once again I have been treated with sympathetic consideration."

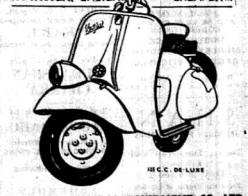

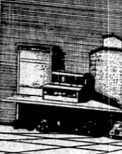

## BRITAIN SEEKS QUICK ACTION TO BREAK TRADE BARRIERS

**Egypt to ask for Suez toll U.K. REFUSAL**

BRITAIN has called on the 17-nation Organisation for European Economic Co-operation to give approval next week to the creation of a European industrial free trade area.

The Government said in a White Paper that the O.E.C.C. Ministerial Council, which meets in Paris on Tuesday and Wednesday, should set up machinery to negotiate arrangements for the area and prepare a draft convention.

Under the scheme, proposed by Britain on January 19, tariff and other trade restrictions would be reduced and eventually abolished. But the British Government insists, because of its Commonwealth commitments, agriculture should be excluded from the plan. In the White Paper, emphasis is laid on an "industrial" free trade area.

**'Great opportunity' ahead**

It stated: "With a population of 250,000,000 there is clearly a great opportunity which Europe can take providing quantitative restrictions throughout Europe. The area is expected to meet 20 per cent more than the present level of normal needs."

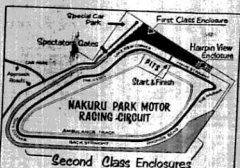

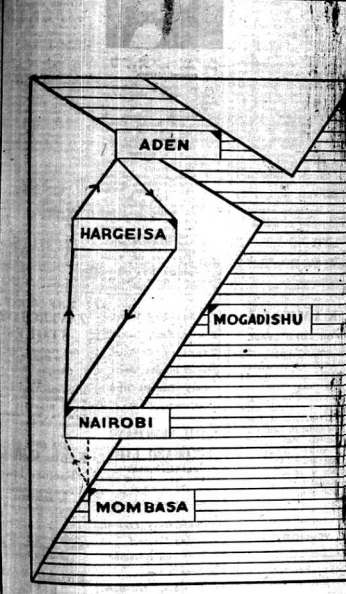
