SOUTH AFRICA WIN 5TH TEST TO SQUARE RUBBER

England tail-enders make gallant bid to save match

SOUTH AFRICA squared the rubber when they defeated England in the fifth and final Test at Port Elizabeth yesterday by 58 runs with day two giving Taylor's four of four. After the first three Tests had been drawn, England's tail-enders, Evans, Lock and Tyson made a gallant but unsuccessful effort to save the match.

South Africa were all out for 114 runs in their second innings losing 14 runs from the last wicket to give England 128 runs for victory.

South Africa had lost their ninth wicket when two of them fell to Evans and Lock who had been dropped.

Cive van Rynsweld, the South African captain, called for the match to be declared a draw to try to break up the pitch.

One or two balls from the fast bowlers, C. E. T. Cowdrey and D. H. Headley, had looked like having a vital effect in the last hour of the match on a breaking pitch in the last session.

Batting order switch The South African innings had started with a bang.

England made a comparatively rapid start with 112 runs coming in 20 minutes. Then Headley and Cowdrey, the last two in the order, added 100.


Watts, who injured his left shoulder in the first Test, was fit again and scored 25 minutes for 25 before being bowled by Adcock.



Mr. CAMERON's letter clearly shows that some of the fears sincerely held by many about the development of Kenya are unfounded.

It is certainly true that gravity has been given to the matter of racial segregation, design, or otherwise, in a number of areas.

Ultimately there can be only two possibilities: one of race over another, or harmony between them. The former cannot be equated with justice, equality, and lightness, and a paternal and that will not do.

The display given by the teenage Netherlands girls at the Olympic Pool at the weekend was the most remarkable seen in Kenya. Kenya has seen many fine athletes, including women, who have been time to time world record holders, but none were in world record class.

The Dutch girls, Mary Kok, Atje Voogt, Nel van der Wal, and others, were current holders of world records.

As is apparent from details of the competition published in the *Standard*, Miss Kok and Miss Van der Wal were the first to break the 50-metres of the backstroke record, swimming against the clock, and they performed wonderfully.

Intensive training

Most swimmers all over the world receive intensive training to take a schedule under which they swim 10 hours a day. This is not always the case, however, and the results may be less than expected.

In the Netherlands, however, they believe that their fitness was particularly good because they would have a strong sense that would have more motivation to train. Their breathing was easily controlled, and they swam in a very straight line.

It is interesting to note that their training techniques were perfectly balanced.

Records easily beaten

Rarely is a single-handed swimmer able to beat these girls, who are obviously well prepared. Their record times were well below those of other countries. We need to see if they made mistakes in their training, or if they did not compete at comparable distances.

With the exception of one unacquainted with top class swimming, the girls swam with the leg "boot" with hand and arm movements. The boot is a device which is strapped to the chest or even folded high up on the back.

Similarly, the same movements above gave them almost identical times. Of course, the effect was very evident, with the leg "boot" being gained from the minimum of disturbance.

It is interesting to note that just below the back, the girls swam in a different approach to getting the fastest times.

In short, the performance of these girls was excellent.
