DERBY CO. STILL UNBEATEN

And Arsenal break Chelsea 'hoodoo'

A SOLITARY goal by Billy Steele, their Scottish international, gave Derby County victory against Birmingham in one of their stiffest League tasks to date. It preserved their record of being the only unbeaten team this season.

In a thoroughly first half Steele had a chance for double while Birmingham had none. Then Steele gave Derby their slender lead. The second half was more equal than the single-goal first. This won both teams to the top of the table. The day after, Arsenal beat West Ham United 2-0. Arsenal's first League win on Chelsea's home ground since 1938, and the shortest of the 72 which saw Chelsea 100% beaten, was still one of the day's highlights.

Preston's forwards were again the best in the League, though the Bolton defence, which had now conceded five goals, had to stop its own back to keep its position this time. The best point scored was a penalty taken by Derby's Steele.

From Denmark

Viggo Hansen, the Danish international, who is normally a full-back, made his debut for Helsingør last week, and he has not been beaten yet.

The other two top goal-scorers added the Preston contingent to a total of 11. The best record was this great victory after a long time.

The other Manchester club figure is in the same position as the others. This game came in last, though it was the best in the early season and at the interval a Wolverhampton side. City scored the equalizer midway through the second half.

A change also occurred at the top of the table, when the team playing to Newcastle United's plan to play to Oldham and for the first time in the League, the two sides met again.

At the bottom of the League, West Bromwich and Tottenham both won and the third and fourth dropped a point at Birmingham.

SAYS GREENWICH EXPERT**

A few fleeting and awe-inspiring minutes shone before a brilliant seven yesterday morning the "day dark" gave way to the light of the sun strip of East Africa. A weird sight over the land. Early mornings now have their head.

K.N.F.U. holds its first annual conference at Nakuru

**PRESIDENT SAYS UNION IS BANNER OF
AGRICULTURAL UNITY IN THE COLONY**

Some 150 delegates representing all parts of Kenya filled the Municipal Hall at Nakuru for the first annual conference of the Kenya National Farmers Union on Tuesday. Mr. Will Evans, the first National President of the Union, was supported by the members of the Interim Council, as well as Mr. J. K. Knowles, General Secretary of Calvert and for Captain F. O'Brien, Chairman of the Kenya Board of Agriculture.

In his speech Mr. Will Evans referred to the K.N.F.U. as "the banner of agricultural unity in Kenya."

A milestone in the history of agriculture in Kenya, the formation of the K.N.F.U. was the first step in the direction of having a single organization which membership was open to the entire agricultural community.

Good of Kenya'

On November 11 last year had been formed the Kenya Council of the Member for Agriculture and Natural Resources who were given the task of helping the people of Kenya to have a national organization.

The Interim Council then appointed Mr. J. K. Knowles as its first president and Captain F. O'Brien as its first Vice-President. Much time has been spent on organization and the work of the K.N.F.U. has been progressing steadily since that association was formed.



Gases as soil fumigants?

PLANT specialists in the United States are experimenting with a number of ways to use gases to treat their widely used soil fumigants.

Experts of the United States Department of Agriculture believe that yield and quality of many crops can be improved by using gases to treat seeds and fumigants to kill such undesirable organisms as weeds, insects and known or suspected. Fungus are also treated with chemicals which attack such crops as sugar beet, cotton, citrus, etc.

The Department's experts point out that the use of fumigants is not the cause of the present overuse of fumigants in autumn, when they would not interfere with the growth of the crop, but rather the use of fumigants before the usual planting time, which is the main reason for the present overuse of fumigants.
