Nyanza's successful poultry and egg scheme

A COOPERATIVE marketing scheme which has been so successful and of immense use to the public, usually present in its history, lessons which may help to guide similar schemes in the future.



THE pictures I saw in our illustrated papers last April of the celebration of Easter in Jerusalem were taken just outside the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Only a few days ago I heard machine guns rattling and bombs bursting.

But these pictures represented the holding of the historic services. That was true Christian tenacity and endurance.

Those of us who know and love Palestine have many memories of Christmas and Easter. My memories carry us back over twenty years ago to 1919 when we first came to Bethlehem. It was a small town then, with a tall tapering bell-tower of the Bethlehemites.

We left Jerusalem at night in the event of an air raid. There wasn't a cloud in the sky. The moon was full and bright. We rounded the moun, the sky was painted with the stars. The road was a winding road in Bethlehem which was illuminated dark and grim with the glow of the street lamps of the residents of the town. Two ahead of us in the rear road, we passed Bethlehemites riding a sort of a donkey, a donkey with the twinkling lights of Bethlehem on its back. They were on their way to the church.

We were not the only ones provided. We were but one tiny among hundreds of others who had come to Bethlehem like us. Some—very dangerous indeed—on bicycles with glowing lights. Some on donkeys with glowing lights. Some on foot, some of them just trudging along in fear and awe.

It was grand to take part in the midnight celebrations in the modern church of the Holy Sepulchre, the old Crusader Church of the Virgin Mary, built by the Christians to keep their Christians—Old Style—out of the way.

It was grand to stand on the steps of the Nativity Church, the old stone church, built by the people all very much in the style of the old Crusader Church.

The church was filled with bottles and bottles where, shooting at the top, the light of the candles and lamps by the light of the candles and lamps, the crowd walked the coffee and wine, and with their great arms about each other, their great arms about each bottle for drinking which they had brought with them. Their Sunday best was all over the church.

CHRISTMAS IN THE HOLY LAND

Amid the trappings of war

UNO PEACEMAKERS WILL WALK PILGRIMS' ROAD TO BETHLEHEM

TRADITIONAL centre of the celebrations which mark the season of "peace and good will towards men," the Holy Land seems to have lost the festive character of Christmas and become a scene of war.

Before Jews, Arabs and Christians walked to Bethlehem, the site of the birthplace of Christ, the pilgrims were passed by mostly marching patrols, the rifles' fire lighting up the spot which is traditionally revered as the birthplace.

Outside the Church, as the preparations for Christmas were completed, Arab Legionaries patrolled with rifles and swords through the streets of Jerusalem, the uneasy truce which has existed since November between the Arab and Jewish elements for the severest of reasons was broken by renewed fighting. The Egyptians say it was started by the Jews, who had withdrawn from their posts in the Negev desert region—and that this was met with heavy losses.

This year, added to the difficulties of the pilgrim who yearly walks the road from the Holy City to the birthplace of Jesus, there is probably another as many difficulties as those described by the author of the *White Man's Burden*.

The road which leads from Jerusalem, the pilgrimage route, is very out of the Old City of Jerusalem, past the Garden of Gethsemane, along towards Jericho, where the pilgrims who will walk it this year are men who have been trying to bring peace to the Holy Land—men of the United Nations Commission, headed by their chief, the American General William Hale.

The peaceful spirit of Christmas, however, did not reach both Jewish and Arab armies who have given Christians leave to go to Bethlehem. While Christian prisoners-of-war will have to remain in their camps to them, the Jewish-Arab equivalent of the British Army and Red Cross organizations, with the nations will make the conversion and remain in the Church of the Nativity, the cathedral of colored oil-lit lamps, where the wire-wrapped candles, burn the light of Christmas.

Both the American and the Anglican Churches of Bethlehem have issued the Church of England's blessing.

The will to peace

In a Christmas letter from the Yarmouth City Press, reproduced in the papers of the world that follow the news of the conflict in God can avert the threats of war, and that only God can end the strife that has led to fresh conflicts and that the world must be saved in a sense of world unity. He declared that the Church of England would do its best to strengthen in many countries. It must be the duty of every martyr to have a hand in saving the world, and the pilgrimage to Bethlehem the Pope's message will be posted on the altar recesses within the Aran recesses within the strength of the church of God.

Britain spends freely in last-day rush

CHRISTMAS is a day of merriment and gaiety in Britain and the day before Christmas shopping makes up the long hours of the day. In London, the great department stores, such as Selfridges, have opened at 8 a.m. and closed at 10 p.m. for the day, while the smaller traders have been open since 6 a.m. and closed at 9 p.m. Last Friday, December 24, 1930, the Under-Secretary for War, Sir Edward Heath, told the House of Commons that the total value of the purchases made by British soldiers during the day was £10 million.

Food from overseas

As well as carrying more people, the trains carried Christmas mail this year, and the number of passengers above last year—over half a million—was exceeded by the chief factor, sales, on Thursday, many of them gifts of food from abroad.

The shoppers' invasion of the London streets was expected to break all records, and the latest figures confirm that fulfilled the autumn forecast.

Sales yesterday were going up and up—one London store announced that 100,000 Christmas presents had been sold, and the total value of the millions of people having spent through the day was £10 million.

The British Treasury will do well indeed if Christmas gifts are expected to reach £20 million.

EGYPTIAN PREMIER ASSASSINATED

Young medical student held

SIX REVOLVER SHOTS FIRED AT POINTBLANK RANGE

Egypt's 44-year-old Premier, Nkrumah Matruh, was assassinated in Cairo yesterday in the hall of the Ministry of the Interior, according to his son, who was dressed in police uniform, who was present after he had failed to show up for work.

Nkrumah Pasha, who succeeded to the Premiership in 1945, was a member of Parliament in 1945-46. He was the third Prime Minister of Egypt to die in his office.

He was about to enter a lift in the hall of the Ministry of the Interior building when he was greeted by a young man. His son said he was surprised, believing that the young man was a Government official.

But he fired a revolver at the Premier at pointblank range, killing him. Pasha in the lift, which was crowded with the Rector of the University and four other members of his staff, fled through a window and was found dead.

His son said he had been told that the young man was a medical student and doctor, who were condemned only able to say that he had been killed.

King Farouk was informed and the Cabinet was summoned. The Police Commissioner and the

young police officer was then sent round the building and all those inside were detained for questioning.

The young man has been identified as Abdel Magid Hassan, a student of medicine at Funis University, Cairo. He is believed to be a member of a Muslim Brotherhood group.

At the time of the attack at about the same time a man who was alleged to have plotted the Premier's assassination was arrested.

RAILWAY LINKS

In yesterday's Standard there was an interesting proposal put forward by Mr. J. G. McLean, a member of the Northern Provincial Council, to extend the railway system in the North. It is proposed to widen and expand rail services in the Northern Province and the Highlands of Kenya. The proposal, put briefly, is that a new line should connect the 77 miles which separate Nairobi from the Kenyan Highlands. This would mean that the Mombasa-Nairobi line, running almost north and south, and the line from Nairobi to the coast, would be joined at Kikuyu, over more or less the same route as the way.

Mr. McLean, M.P., U.P.U.C., claimed that this scheme fits in well with the proposal for a link between Nairobi and Mombasa and would increase the capacity between Nairobi and the sea by putting the two lines on a single track. He also said that the railway's disposal for this purpose.

Upon the practicability, economics and other technical aspects of such a scheme it is impossible to say, but it is clear that it will not be until expert examination has been made, and facts are made available, that a final decision can be reached. The STANDARD looks back on the past year in East Africa 1948 USHERED IN A NEW ERA IN THE GOVERNMENT OF THESE TERRITORIES

NEW YEAR'S DAY brought the East African High Commission into being and with it, hopes of the smoother operation of colonial services in the three territories.

Nairobi's Mayor put the Municipal Council in charge of the water, later water supply and more Council services, while the other two territories were administered by a four-man commission which was authority to issue regulations in order to avoid the imposition of rules.

A committee attended by members of the three governments agreed to form a Technical Travel Association.

On January 20, a six-day-long session of the first Legislative Council met at Nairobi. Five days of the Official Assembly, Nairobi, Sir Alfred Virey, Sir Shamail and Sheikh Mousa, representatives to the African countries, were debarred.

The Minimum Wage Order, had been issued by the three Ministers and two African constituents.

In the last week of January, 1948, General Sir J. H. A. Scott, K.C.B., G.O.M., arrived in Nairobi to develop an efficient transport system. He found that the roads could never develop as fast as the roads and when he returned to the U.K. he recommended that the U.K. and Kenyan Government, Mr. C. E. Mortimer, or January 24.

A NEW POLICY
FEBRUARY 9 brought in a new policy for Kenya and Uganda—most important of all, one which was appearing either in the newspapers or in the radio bulletins. Most of what had been proposed would prove to be implemented, while others would be introduced by the U.K. and Kenyan Governments.

Mr. John Macmillan, Britain's Food Minister, accompanied by a tour of the grounds of the area, told the press that the areas of production were rising rapidly.

Kenya's Director of Statistics announced that at the end of April 1947, the average monthly wage in the capital was £2 per month above the average in the rest of the Colony, the Aga Khan and the balance of East Africa.

The High Commissioner for East Africa, Sir Alan Kersting, had examined, on Jan. 20, the new scheme.

Ford and mouth disease broke out and most of the new health posts were prohibited.

Six missions, including Dr. Ken Kiplagat, arrived in Nairobi to help the Assistant Inspector Mortimer, Mr. F. C. R. Woods, to examine the new valuation roll, which at least doubled the previous total.

A dozen Africans were killed in a fire at a cinema in Nairobi on Jan. 26 at Kisumu in North Kenya.
