DELAY ON CYPRUS

BRITAIN'S new defence plan, involving the Army's most drastic peacetime changes, is understood to have been discussed when the Queen received the Secretary for War, Mr. John Hare, and the C.I.G.S., Field Marshal Sir Gerald Templer, at Buckingham Palace.

The Queen is Colonel-in-Chief of several regiments, and political observers said that under the reorganisation some famous regiments might lose their identities.

A Government White Paper in April forewarned of an expenditure this year from £100 to £25,000, with the aim of an all-Britain force of 375,000 by the end of 1952. National Service is to end by 1952.




Queen's portrait for Sandhurst



BRITAIN PREPARING MEASURES TO COMBAT INFLATION

Talks on setting up advisory committee FEARS BY UNIONS

BRITISH Ministers are this week working on proposals to maintain the country's economy on a stable basis and end the current danger of inflation. It was reported yesterday.

The Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. MacLeod, and the Minister of Labour, Mr. Morrison, are to hold talks on the possibility of setting up an independent committee of experts to advise on productivity and price controls.

They will meet leaders of the Trades Union Congress, the National Industrial and Employer's Organisations, the National Union of Public Employees, and the National Union of Marine Cooks and Stewards. Government spokesmen have indicated that the official body is to be a more friendly reception than given the plan to set up such a committee.

Effect on Kenya not known

In Kenya, the Minister of Finance, Mr. Vasey, said yesterday that it was not possible to estimate what effects the British crisis might have on the Colony's economy. This would not be known until Mr. MacLeod's explanation of the proposals had been made.

Mr. Vasey said that the Government's policy was to keep down wages and control prices. He said that the Government would not be able to do this unless it had a more friendly reception than given the plan to set up such a committee.

Nakuru inquiry opens into widow's death

"Standard" Staff Reporter Nairobi.

DESCRIBING her uneasiness after calling a few minutes without reply from the house of a widow living at her house, Dr. Harriet M. Arnold said at a Nakuru magistrate's court yesterday that she finally looked through a side window and saw the widow's body lying on a bed.
