

EXTENSIONS PROPOSED FOR SERENGETI PARK

Special nature sanctuary in craters: Game corridor

LINK WITH MARA RESERVE

IMPORTANT revisions to the boundaries of the Serengeti National Park are recommended in the report of the Committee of Inquiry, published today. The Committee, which was headed by Sir Barclay Nihill, set up in public at Arusha late June and early July, has recommended that the boundaries of the park be extended to include extensions of the present park in the Western Serengeti. The Committee recommends that the Ngorongoro and Embagai craters should be excluded. The craters would, however, become "nature sanctuaries" reserved to the Government, and be surrounded by a special conservation zone to be controlled by the Tanganyika Government. The land between the proposed park and the conservation units would be a game-controlled area to ensure a migration corridor for wild animals.

Limited value to humans

The recommendations for the Western Serengeti marine extensions in the south-west of the existing park, enclosing of a small gap between the western boundary and the northern boundary, and the extension north to join up with the Mara "National Reserve" in Kenya, are also recommended. The park would then be 1,200 square miles in area.

Adoption of the suggestions would make the Western Serengeti a "natural area" under the definition given in the Tanganyika Government's White Paper.

The Committee stated: "The Western Serengeti is only of marginal value to man, and the areas which have been continued occupied will rapidly deteriorate."

It was recommended that it could be maintained and improved. As such, it would have high aesthetic and educational value as well as great scientific interest to the people of Tanganyika but for all those throughout the world concerned with the survival of the species.

The Committee "fully accepts" the suggestion that a special provision should be made for the protection of the environment in the use of the crater areas for pasture purposes.

The flocks of the 120 craters should not be controlled by the Government, but established by the local communities concerned with their use.

The Serengeti was unique, and only in possessing certain qualities of its own could it be considered as having a natural value of its own.

It was the desire of the Committee that no further steps be taken to improve the park, and it was therefore the recommendation that no further practical measures to preserve the park should be taken.

As far as the Cratello Highlands were concerned, the Committee suggested that they should be forest and water conserving areas, and the interests of man, with wild life,

were not very difficult to reconcile, the Committee said.

FINANCIAL AID SUGGESTION

The Committee considers that protection of forest resources will be necessary, that small plots of land should be available for the use of the local population, and that special legislation should be established in the centre and southern parts of the park to ensure no encroachment on the land.

Additional recommendations are that the local population should be encouraged to grow trees, and that research should be drawn upon to assist the local population in the use and conservation of the forest resources.

The Committee suggested that financial aid be carried out to help the people from sources outside the park.

WATER SUPPLY URGED FOR AREA NORTH OF MOMBASA

Mzima branch pipeline

An appeal for greater efforts to be made to supply water to the mainland north of Mombasa was made in Kenya's legislative Council yesterday by Major G. H. N. Clark, MP, who headed the second reading of the Mzima Branch Pipeline Bill.

Mr. Clark said it was clearly due to a scarcity of water that an area extending up to 30 miles from the coast and shown no sign of developing. He had been informed at fairly recent date that the Mzima-Mombasa pipeline did not tap any streams which were the chief source of endangering the present supply to residents, to provide water for the area.

He quoted a memorandum about the matter from the Government about eight weeks ago, in which the Government said that there was no sign of development, which was such a small residential area, and that the water was endangering the present supply to residents, to provide water for the area.

Introducing the bill, Mr. Clark said: "All that I can say is that it was considered necessary to set up a statutory authority to manage the water supplies of Mombasa," he said.

This is stated in the annual report of the Director of Civil Service, which said that the new state of affairs will be brought about by the creation of a new authority to manage the water supply and board and might be called the Mombasa Water Board.

During the year 1951 applications for water were received. The board has now received and rejected 723 applications for water, and 1,230 applications for water were received. The board authorised 5,230 applications for water.

An officer with the Mombasa Water Board said: "The Appeals Tribunal has ruled that the Mombasa Water Board must be allowed to manage the water supply under the new scheme."

TB STILL KENYA'S MAJOR HEALTH WORRY Medical report for 1956

NO serious epidemic occurred in Kenya in 1956, although typhoid fever was still transmitted in certain areas. There has been a steady increase in Tuberculosis cases, and patchy distribution of the disease poses a challenging epidemiological problem.

The most important and difficult aspect of the disease is the way the Disease has had to spread. A fairly organized scheme of survey and control of the disease and supervision was worked out during the year.

Early detection was also well maintained and, though it hardly seemed to have been so far as possible, its prevalence had been reduced.

Surveillance and control of the disease campaigns to ensure the early detection of cases and the control of outbreaks.

Staff expansion

The report goes on to say that the staff of the Medical Department is established and training staff to control the disease has been given a necessary recognition and support.

At the same time, more medical and nursing staff and additional medical expenses had to be arranged to meet the needs of the Medical Department for services to the individual.

There was a rise of over 30,000 hospital admissions in 1956 compared with 1955, and the number of beds required were increased. Work and efforts were made to improve the chemotherapy of service with the introduction of new drugs and the use of the new drugs in the treatment of the report adds.

Existing hospitals and other facilities were not able to cope with the high standard during 1956, but the department had to recognize the need for further development and the building of new hospitals and clinics.

MAU MAU DETAINEES TAKE COLONIAL SECRETARY Works camp visit: Tribute to Kikuyu HOPE ON FUTURE

THE COLONIAL SECRETARY, Mr. Lennox-Boyd, was cheered by 300 detainees at a Kikuyu Works Camp, near Fort Hall yesterday. He had addressed the detainees at the camp to see for himself the part of the rehabilitation pipeline for Mau Mau.

Standing bare-headed in the sun, the Colonial Secretary recalled that he was near Kangens three years ago. Things were then very different for everyone, he said.

"Now, everything is a great deal better. Your country is at peace. Children can go to school in safety. Schools are open. Much more wants are being met."

History repeats itself ACT OF FAITH UNDERTAKEN IN EMERGENCY

1411. In that year was it Guy de la Brosse, of London, began to be born? and in an age of cold and light, castles made into a farce and a jester house, like now aperçus. *Chronicles of Alexander Fabien of Farrington Ward Without (1460)*

HISTORY, especially in the unfolding of the story of its urban communities, has an uncanny way of calling "snap" down its centuries, if to make us think that those tastes and methods of men of former days and their problems and aspirations are there again. In medieval London's Guildhall, 500 miles and five centuries — from George Washington to Nairobi's new City Hall of course — were born.

Yet the reasons for the building of them were not dissimilar. At the end of the 14th century, London was experiencing a period of economic prosperity; it had a home and a permanent seat of government, and a court of justice; it was a thriving and growing town, looking confidently forward to the future. Like Nairobi today, the City was the seat of Government, the hub of Government, the large area, and a centre for foreign trade and diplomatic representation.

Proud of the future

As the historian, Nairne, put it in his extract from the *Extracts of the Extraordinary Council of the City of London*, 1401, "The town proclaims the honour of its birth, and the greatness of its Extentions, to form, with the rest of the Empire, a world; and the desire of the inhabitants to future either to increase or to defend the empire of which they will be born."

The old Town Hall, as it was then known, was in 1359, sharing with the Law Courts, the Strand, in the open area known as City Court, the site of the present-day Central Library. It was last in July, 1404, by His Lordship, the Mayor, and his Lady, Countess of Lancashire, that the Lord Mayor, the Corporation and the burgesses became a municipal corporation.

The contractors for the new building, however, were not chosen until there were residents at present in the city who had been posted there when the site had been picked — and the first big job by Africans — and were wondering what to do with the new buildings.

In 1404, during the planning of the new building, the Corporation had decided to build a hall and theatre seats about 800 and a room for the use of the burgesses, with a room above for the use of the townsmen below, the magistrates, the burgesses, the scholars, advocates,


