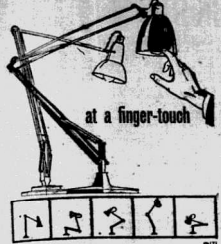

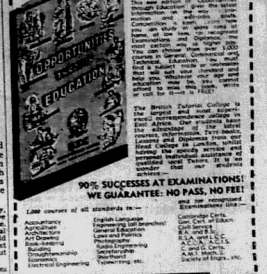

ROSES, ROSES ALL THE WAY FOR A ROYAL BRIDE . . .

It is May 6, 1960, a Friday, and streets in the heart of London are gay with roses and flags for the wedding of a Royal Princess to a commoner. The Princess is Margaret, the gay, beautiful 29-year-old sister of the Queen. The bridegroom is 30-year-old Anthony Armstrong-Jones who, until his engagement to the Princess last February, was a professional photographer.

It seems as though the great city has hardly slept through the night. Lights have shone from the windows of Buckingham Palace and most of the colorful wedding procession. In Army barracks, soldiers have polished and repolished boots and buckles. There is a holiday atmosphere as the crowds thicken along the pavements and military bands and troops march to their posts on the route. The Mall, the wide, pleasant boulevard which cuts straight from workaday London to Buckingham Palace, is spanned by a tall and graceful arch of red and pink roses. Climbing roses wind up tall, delicate masts each surmounted by a Princess's coronet. Large, white crowd-bearing banners hang out over the heads of the gold-encased monogram "M.A." — for Margaret and Antony — inscribed on the background of a red rose. The rose theme is a reminder that the Princess was christened Margaret Rose.

The crowd cheers as each Missions from Buckingham Palace, bearing guests, passes on its way to Westminster Abbey. 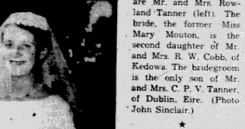

BAD FARMERS FAVOURED, MEMBER PROTESTS

The Minister for Agriculture should have produced his 10-year farm plan before the debate on the Land Development Finance Bill, says Mr. Briggs (Wang Nyaka) in the Legislative Council on Wednesday.

If only land of high potential was to be purchased for the 10-year farm plan, this would place the farmers at a great advantage over other farmers who had fully developed their properties, Group Capt. Briggs said.

Earlier the House had debated the Land Development Finance Bill, which would provide for the distribution of the Government's 10-year farm plan. Similar dangers would, however, arise if there was to be a purchase of land for the purpose of restoring and stabilising the values for the East African Community, Mr. Briggs continued.

U.K. responsibility
Group Capt. Briggs said he was certain that the Government would not insure a scheme for farmers in the shape of a land development plan, rather than that of the Colonial Office.
