Great War Crimes Trial Ends 12 NAZI LEADERS SENTENCED TO DEATH Three Found Not Guilty

RUSSIAN JUDGES DISSENT

Palace of Justice, Nuremberg, October 1.

The climax to the great Nazi War Crimes Trial at Nuremberg, Germany, in three sittings which started disastrously by the President of the Tribunal, Lord Justice Lawrence of Great Britain.

Defendant Hermann Wilhelm Goering, on the counts of the indictment on which he has been convicted the Tribunal sentenced you to death by hanging.

In precisely similar terms Lord Justice Lawrence passed the following sentences on the other Nazi accused who had been convicted.

Rudolf Hess—Implication for life; Joachim von Ribbentrop—Death by hanging; Arthur Seyss Inquart—Death by hanging; Ernst Kaltenbrunner—Death by hanging; Alfred Rosenberg—Death by hanging; Julius Rosenberg—Death by hanging; Walter Funk—Implication for life; Martin Bormann—50 years imprisonment; Fritz Sauckel—Death by hanging; Alfred Zoss—Death by hanging; Arthur Speer—20 years imprisonment; Constantin von Neurath—10 years imprisonment; Martin Winterbottom—Death by hanging.

Chief Justice, Vice President and judges were found not guilty and ordered to be discharged by court martial when the Tribunal retired.

After the sentence of Martin Bormann (in his absence) the President of the Court said:

"I have an announcement to make. The Soviet member of the International Military Tribunal desires to record his dissent from the decision in the case of the defendant, Hans Papan and Pritzsche. He is of the opinion that they should have been convicted and not acquitted.

"He also dissents from the decision in respect of the Reich Cabinet and the General Staff and the High Command, being of the opinion that they should have been convicted and not acquitted.

"The dissenting opinions will be put into writing and annexed to the judgment and will be published as soon as possible."

The dissenting opinion will be put into writing and annexed to the trial case to a close and the eight judges fled from the bench and out of the door at the back of the court.

Tanganyika's Timber Problems

[FROM A CORRESPONDENT]

At a special meeting of the Tanganyika Timber Association, held at the Hotel de Ville, Paris, on September 29, 1943, the following resolutions were passed:

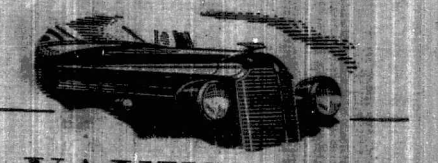

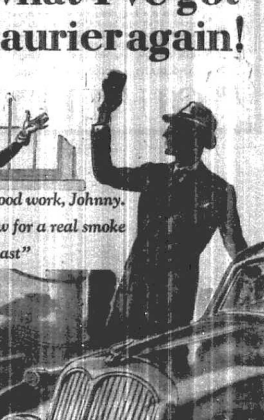

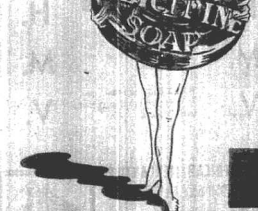

MUCH has been written on the feeding of cattle in Kenya, but an examination of official and other many official statements that are made from the grain which is raised in the district shows that there is a great deal of error in the light of the facts.

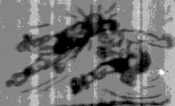

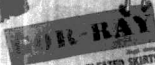

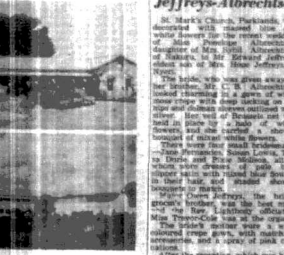
