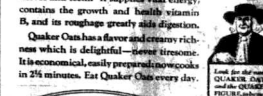



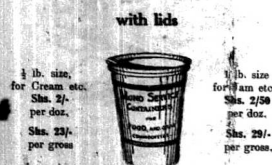

The Government intended to take up the Report. Major Dale asked if it could be the form that these Commissions were set up by the London end should be given a chance to be heard.

The Chairman agreed that was a very important point, in view of the cases as the London end might be given a chance. He suggested that on a practical basis the matter was it was more important that a general question were asked, they would, he was sure only get a general answer.

London Wants a Question. Major Walsh said the question was that before these Commissions were sent out to report on business matters, the economic development of the territories should be given an opportunity to be heard as they were the main basis as they supplied the finance.

On Major Walsh's suggestion questions should be asked of the Secretary of State as to the effect of the Report regarding the suggestion of pulling up of the line between Kabu and Nairobi; whether he proposed to dispose of private other via the remaining part of the line, and assuming they want no further private decision was reached, and to add that these might be further information had been received from the territory.

Major Walsh said that as regards the Armitage Smith Report they might ask about the £70,000 being put annually for the transport of officials and from Tanganyika, whilst about 20 per cent of the natives were in taxation default.

In this connection Major Dale reminded them that Tanganyika was a Mandated Territory and therefore the Report on it was bound to require the most careful attention of the Secretary of State; which would be reported to the Mandates Commission.

It was agreed that there was two points to be considered—any action in regard to the Report, already published, and action in regard to future reports. As regards the future it was agreed that when matters relating to economic development in the future were brought up they should be entitled to be heard by the Commission before its report was put forward.

At the 18th Report, after all the members of the Commission had communicated with all the territories, it was suggested that the Secretary of State should be sent in any questions on any of the two Reports, the Armitage Smith and Gibbs, and this could be embodied in the Commissions' address.

ADDITIONS TO BURDEN OF FARMER AND NATIVE AVOIDED.

A special general meeting of the Nairobi Chamber of Commerce has been called for Tuesday, March 7, to approve a memorandum proposing alternative forms of taxation to meet the deficit in the Kenya Budget instead of imposing Income Tax.

The alternatives suggested by a Committee of the Chamber are:

- 1. Tax of 1 per cent on the registration of companies. This is expected to produce £10,000.
2. A prime tax of 1 per cent, on the c.i.f. value of goods entering into and remaining Kenya—£28,000.
3. Revision of trade licence fees on the basis of the Tanganyika Ordinance—£82,000.
4. A graduated non-originate poll tax on the lines in force in Tanganyika—£60,000.

On a very conservative basis it is estimated that in a full year these four proposals would produce at least £180,000 additional revenue.

The Committee stresses the fact that every care has been taken to avoid adding to the burden of the farmer or of imposing fresh taxation on the African.

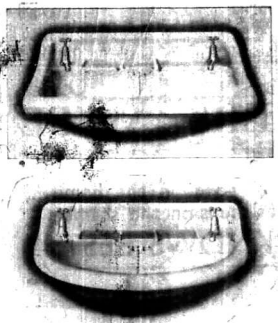

The new President has indicated that he will spare no effort to restore world trade by international action but the emergency at home cannot wait that accomplishment.

President's Prayer: "So Help Me God."

The Federal Reserve Bank has advanced its minimum rate from 2 1/2 to 3 per cent.

As a consequence of the banking crisis, 30 States have now taken action of some kind or other to prevent uncontrolled withdrawals of deposits.

Only one State, namely South Carolina, is now unaffected by the banking crisis. All financial and commodity markets throughout the United States are closed.

A three-day bank holiday has been declared in New York State and in Illinois.

Washington, March 4 - Mrs. Eisenhower watched Mr. Hoover and Mr. Roosevelt's resignation from the White House to the Capitol today.

After Mr. Hoover had signed legislation passed during the closing hours of Congress, Mr. Roosevelt stepped on to the platform.

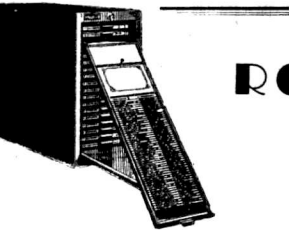
