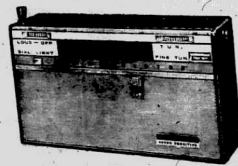

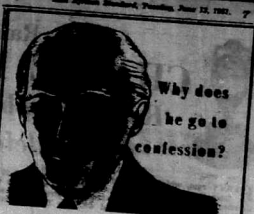



Two amendments to Government proposal defeated

Opposition members stage walk-out

NOT even the whisper of a 'no' was heard in the Kenya Legislative Council last night when the Government motion on constitutional amendments was put to the House and passed without a division. But the victorious Government found itself facing empty Opposition benches.

The entire Opposition group, with its European and Asian supporters, departed from its usual practice of forcing the Government to a division and expressed its disapproval of the Government motion on constitutional amendments by walking out in a body as the Leader of Government Business, Mr. Ngila, rose to make his closing speech.

The walk-out immediately on the heels of the defeat of an amendment proposed by Mr. T. J. Mbiya (Nairobi) calling for a constitutional conference before the next session of the Council. Earlier in the day an amendment by Mr. A. O. Odiga (Central Nyanza) calling on the British Government to give an independence date for 1961 had also been defeated.

KANU MAY BOYCOTT COUNCIL IN MASS PROTEST

KANU leaders last night proposed a total boycott of the Legislative Council as a protest against the Kenya Government's proposal for independence in 1961.

The proposal was made in a meeting of the Kenya Independence Council which was held in Nairobi last night.

The meeting was held in the presence of Mr. J. M. Nyagah (Embu), who is also the Deputy Speaker. He listened impassively to Mr. Ngila's speech, which contained vigorous attacks on his colleagues. With him on the Opposition benches were Mr. E. L. Howard-Williams (Nairobi West) and three Kenya African Party members, Mr. Clive Satter (Nairobi West), Mr. David Cole (Nairobi West) and Mr. L. R. Welwood (West Kenya).

Two invitations

As the Opposition moved to the doors in a tight huddle Mr. Ngila immediately opened his remarks with "I am glad to see the cowardly Opposition walking out." He extended two invitations to his absent opponents. "The Opposition should either come back to the ceremony," he said, "or we shall invite them to the ceremony. We shall also invite them to an independence conference."

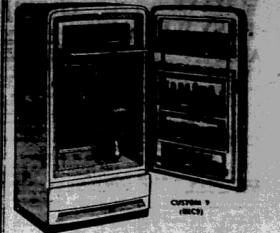

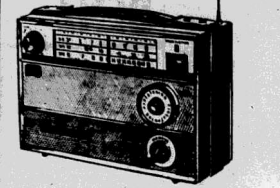
