NOW, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Ordinance, 1951, the Member for Labour, with the approval of the Governor in Council, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Wages Regulation (Soft Furnishings) Order, 1952, and shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1952.

2. The remuneration to be paid and the conditions of employment to be provided to and for all employees engaged in the making up of soft furnishings as specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be less favourable than the remuneration and conditions specified in the said Schedule.

2. The remuneration to be paid and the conditions of employment to be provided to and for all employees engaged in the Trade as defined in the Schedule to this Order shall be less favourable than the remuneration and conditions specified in the said Schedule.

The Kenya Drama Festival At The National Theatre

THEATRICAL history will be made during the coming week when Kenya's first Drama Festival is held in the National Theatre on Monday and Tuesday, July 22 and 24. Railway Players

Since its foundation the N.A.D.S. has produced some 15 full length plays and many shorter productions. In spite of the Emergency the society's activities continue unabated and its present production of *Shakespeare's The Merchant of Venice* will long be remembered. Simultaneously with the production of *Shakespeare's The Merchant of Venice*, the Railway Players have started on the production of *Shakespeare's A Yorkshire Tragedy* for October.

The Railway Players are one of the earliest of the country's dramatic societies, being founded in 1929 for the production of plays of good literary and dramatic quality not normally seen in the Colony. Originally this society presented its plays in the small hall of the old Railway Club, but when the hall failed to meet the requirements of the local life, it had to extend its activities so as to include better-off attractions that could be presented in Nairobi's theatre, although as far as possible works of quality continued to be presented.

Macterinck

The name of James Macterinck is inextricably linked with the Railway Players and it is due to his small measure to him that their high standard, not only in Shakespeare, but in the production of large-scale operas and other plays has been so able maintained. For the Festival, the Railway Players are presenting *Matterinck's Interior*.
