





### More Africans in senior police posts

#### Uganda report on 1952

"Senior" has become a word which is used in the Uganda Police but, as the result of the increase in European technical staff, it has become possible to train them in operating duties and to widen the scope of their activities with considerable advantage to the service. It is the 1952 annual report of the Uganda Police Force that sets out the technical staff and the increase in the number of African police officers in the force. The report continues: "The number of African police officers in the force at the end of the year (1952) is 1,181, 72,000 in 1952."

# THE SECRETS OF BOWLING

There is nothing mysterious about being a good bowler. The essentials are control of length and direction. But you get neither of these vital qualities without hard work and practice. If you aspire to greatness you must realize from the start that there is no easy road - it is just practice, practice and more practice. Bowling is hard work.

By practice I don't mean just aiming the ball down in the nets on hour or two a week. Concentration is as necessary to bowling as to batting.

I've found my length and direction suffer immediately I stop concentrating. Then the whole thing becomes a waste of energy.

### Took me hours

When I began to practice seriously I put a sheet of newspaper on what I considered the spot for a good length. Then I tried to pitch the ball on the paper and at the same time hit one stump. I did it for hours - but always took a brief rest every six balls. If I felt a bit out of form I will do the same thing now.

As to bowling the new men be to get the maximum result with the least effort, I will try to conserve my energy for the actual delivery and to make the batsman play as far as may be possible. To achieve, that the run is vital, increasing the pace is comfortable and just long enough to make your bowler

### Keep head high

Look at the batsman over the left shoulder that will keep the ball high. For the left leg,

properly tanned and at the end of the run, the bowler should reach the crease. A run-up that is too wide wastes energy.

### Suit yourself

There is no hard-and-fast rule about distance. Every bowler must suit himself. When I started bowling I was the most over-right arm over as high as possible. And, finally, being and straighten the left leg on the moment the ball is on the way.
