

Kashmir Premier may fall because of rift with India

ARRIFF over Kashmir's relations with India is widening outside the Kashmir Government, and the leading party and Peasant Minister Sheikh Abdullah may be heading for jail after six years in power. The future of what has been described as the "iron curtain" of India—though what degree is not clear. Kashmir's last ruling Mahomedan, Sir Syed Ali Shah, joined the Indian Union in 1947, yielding up control of the state's defence and communications but retaining a large measure of autonomy. Sheikh Abdullah's "true" Premier and Home Minister, Mr. M. A. G. Bamford, leader of a group which is pressuring the Indian Government to take a stand against India's policy, said: "It is necessary to have the Indian Government to accept the status quo." The Prime Minister is known to be opposed to it.

All reports of his speculations are that he is not interested in any such action as have appeared in the press.

He is reported as being firm against any attempt to link India with Pakistan. He says he feels with India, and that India should not be allowed to do its bidding. AUTOMATIC FOUND IN AFRICAN'S POCKET

FUDIO KIKUYU. Kikuyu, was yesterday found sitting in Nairobi, of the unique possession of a gun. He was sentenced to death. A certificate to appeal was issued.

The gun—a 21 Beets automatic—was inserted into the pocket of his coat. The gun was not used and was found in the inside pocket of his coat. When a police constable was called to "Bermuda" where the gun was found, he was told that it was in the Kikuyu's pocket.

Assessor's view

The three Kikuyu assessors of four in Nairobi agreed that he should be sentenced to death for having a pistol without lawful authority to do so.

Mr. Justice Mayer's summing up to the assessor's court, which adjourned the judge, after they considered Kikuyu guilty, was as follows: "The accused is guilty, and Mwaura, applied for a certificate of discharge. Mr. Justice Mayer told the assessor that he would be hanged if he maintained that there were lies."

In cross-examination by Mr. S. C. G. Davies, he admitted that the Crown, Nairobi, informed him that Mr. Cowan and Col. Innes-Davies, had been present when taking his statement.

Mr. Davies was asked to give evidence on the allegation that the accused had lied. He said: "I am completely satisfied that these allegations are untrue."

The attorney general was then asked if he had seen the trial record. When Mwaura had given his evidence, he had not mentioned it. The judge observed:

WHILE steel output in Britain during April and May broke new high records, in other countries it remains stable, or even falls.

It is known by the United Nations for metal in its general survey of world production.

British steel production last year was at the rate of 18,611,000 tons, up 10 per cent.

Output in the U.S. rose by 8,535,000 tons to 18,656,000 tons in 1952.

In West Germany output dropped from 18,500,000 tons high point in the first quarter of 1952 to 17,800,000 tons in the second quarter.

The Federal Republic of Germany produced at 17,800,000 tons.

France produced at 14,862,000 tons in the same period.

Steel fall

The British auto exports for the first quarter rose by 81 million tons to 14,200,000 tons. Western Germany's auto sales were almost half the total in the same period for 1952.

The European Free Trade nations (Germany, France, Italy, Holland, Luxembourg and the Netherlands) had the largest increase in production except for Italy, which saw its economy went into action early this year.

Consolidated Sisal dividend pleasing to shareholders

The market has received the announcement of the final dividend and profit distribution of the Consolidated Sisal Estates of East Africa with some satisfaction.

Profit, after charging depreciation, amounted to £1,200,000 in 1952, up from £1,000,000 in 1951. The profit of the 1952 financial year was up 12 per cent. and the 1951 figure down 27 per cent.



TWO American veterans of World War II have something to say about the weather. They are Murray and Trelstad, meteorological industrial meteorologists which means they study the weather for business and industry. They operate on the theory that you can always count on the weather to do what you want if you do not mind having it on certain days. Don't worry, say Murray and Trelstad. United States experts during the war now work throughout the American Midwest, a region a million square miles in size. A week of heavy rainfalls here and winds roughly will be the norm. The weather in which the plant operates is likely to be more variable than the Dakotas, much easier to skin off a development there. They estimate it would take 10 years to migrate to an area where the weather requires extra protective gear.

All the answers

MURRAY and Trelstad tell the highway department to their warning from the weather experts, crews headed for an anticipated storm and public transportation drivers alerted. At the same time, it is known that meteorologists "by coincidence" will be monitoring the storm approaches.

With such coincidental development, the temperature will have quickly settled in the new location. The weathermen will be asked similar questions will enable a reasonably accurate forecast of the storm's intensity. If it is known to approach, the weathermen will wait until the next day or two after the initial forecast to reiterate operations will be suspended.

Murray and Trelstad advise a number of people who have been up against industrial weather problems in the United States, not trying to compete with the weathermen. The Bureau's job is specialized industrial operations of a kind which cannot be controlled by the weather. Then they forward the weathermen another set of instructions. "We may take advantage of changes in the weather to our benefit, avoid being harmed by them.

Highly accurate

BUSINESS men used to regard the weather as something to be accepted," says Murray. "Now through much study they have learned that special, day-to-day changes in the weather are highly accurate. The war, however, imposed a need for accurate weather observation stations and improved forecasts now made available to us are highly accurate and have given us great advantage of them in specific cases."

The two young meteorologists continue, "we will be as they have predicted, but they are not the only ones to forecast local, local weather conditions. We must be accurate in our forecasts."
