COPPER: Although copper was probably the first metal to be worked by man it is not until the beginning of the 20th century that copper mining has become a major industry.

The production of copper had long been supported by Europe, and although in his family's private collection he has a number of ancient Greek and Roman coins depicting copper, he has never seen one before his recent return.

After intensive prospecting, copper deposits were finally found on the banks of the Lufwanyama River in 1924, and the company in 1925 began making copper ore. At that time there was no port, so the ore had to be shipped by rail to the coast at Dar es Salaam.

Today the output of the industry is 150,000 tons per annum, and the copper production in Northern Rhodesia is valued at £25,000,000.

Fall and subsequent increase in our imports to Northern Rhodesia in market and industrial trade in the territory is reflected elsewhere in our exports.
