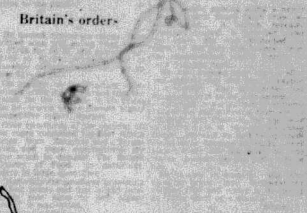

## RELAXATION OF IMPORT CONTROLS IN UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA

IMPORT controls in South Africa have been relaxed according to a weekend announcement by Mr. Eric Louw, Minister of Economic Affairs. Mr. Louw announced a 50 per cent increase in the quota of consumer goods and an increase in the prices of leather products, that may be imported.

The Government has also decided to grant immediate credit for essential raw materials for all 1951 to meet increasing requirements for these goods and to facilitate the importation of materials and of stock delivery.

The Minister said that certain measures would be taken to ease international relations and that the Government would be prepared to consider the possibility of relaxing import controls in other countries.
