



FALL IN WOOL PRICES GIVES RISE TO EXAGGERATED HOPES AND FEARS

THE wool sales in Melbourne and London last week recorded the first important fall in prices for many months—without a hitch. The Times points out, however, that the hopes and fears of the wool growers are inspired by the possibility that retail prices of woolen goods may, in their turn, go down.

The news is one of gloom to South Africa, Australia and New Zealand, who see the wool price being set by the fashion designer of the moment.

Both fiber and wool have fallen in price since the start of the year. The wool price in London has fallen from 100 to 95. The wool price in Melbourne has fallen from 100 to 95.
