EAST AFRICAN TEA EXPORTS IN 1950 WERE THE HIGHEST FOR FIVE YEARS

TEA exports from Kenya, Uganda and Tanganyika during last year were the highest for five years. The 1950 total was 12,579,000 lb. which has only twice before exceeded—in 1948 when 12,485,000 lb. were exported and in the record year of 1942 when the territories together exported 14,044,000 lb.

Last year's figure represents a 25 per cent increase over the 1949 total. The destination for the largest amount of 1950 East African tea was Canada, the British West Indies and the United States and the United Kingdom.

In 1950, Kenya exported 9,771,000 lb. more tea to countries other than the United Kingdom than the year 1949. The total was 1,317,000 lb. 
