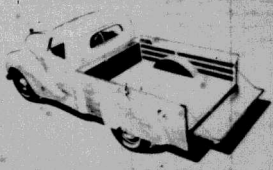

**COMMONWEALTH TRADE CONFERENCE TO BE HELD IN LONDON IN JUNE**

The economic development of British Colonial territories will be among subjects discussed at the seventeenth Congress of Chambers of Commerce of the British Empire, which is to be opened in London in June by Princess Elizabeth. The Congress is organized by the Federation of Chambers of Commerce of the British Empire and its principal object is to give an opportunity to businessmen from all parts of the Commonwealth to meet and discuss their problems.

The Federation holds a Congress every three years alternately in London and elsewhere in the Commonwealth.

The last Congress, Johannesburg in September 1929, drew a wide range of representatives from trade and industry throughout the Empire and gave the first Congress of the kind to be held in Africa.

The 17th Congress will be held at the London Convention Centre, London, from June 10 to 15, 1933.

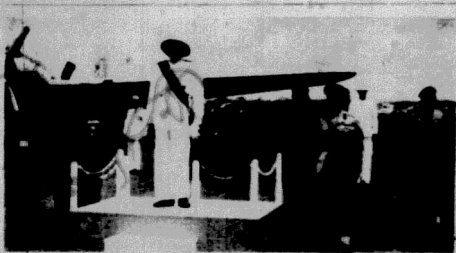

#### STATEMENTS BY AGRICULTURAL AND PRICE CONTROL DEPARTMENTS

MINISTER AGRICULTURE announced today that the prices of butter, cheese, milk and sugar in Kenya are raised in the case of all these commodities with the additional exception of sugar that imports have to be made at higher freight rates.

There is a retail increase of seven cents per lb. for sugar imported from the United States.
