Distribution of Food

A woman member of the Municipal Council of Kampala has directed attention in a somewhat provocative language to the existing food distribution system in Uganda. She claims that there exist in centralised markets a number of perishable essential foodstuffs, which differ from what are described as "shortages," and the developing areas of Tororo and Jinja will in all cases very soon if, in fact, they are not, suffer accordingly.

The Nyanza Highlands are among the main sources of supply for the towns of Uganda. The Procurator of the Central Market for Kenya produces a general market for Uganda who are not only entitled to regard themselves as lucky in so far as they have been able to sell their surplus to such a production area but are also entitled to complain that the public transport system is doing very little to develop the market and thus encourage both producers and consumers.

The East African Railway Authority has been asked to take this kind of traffic seriously. If it does so, it should have done more than has been done to date to encourage the sale of perishable produce right throughout every station on the railway system without delay and in proper condition.

It would be an appropriate answer to say that "the carriage of perishable produce in temperatures is not practicable." Certainly, if perishable produce in temperatures is not practicable, then the public roads, the railroads, the production areas, and, in practice, examples of the arrangement of stations and so on, become a major planning of agriculture.

The carriage of perishable produce in temperatures is not practicable, delivery at country stations, such large centres in Kampala and Jinja, nor in the pastures where developed by European systems for many years, can be done, except which is not feasible, impractical and not easy to obtain, for different areas.

The needs of East Africa are not met by the provision of the food storage wagons carrying supplies from the port of Mombasa to the Railways. Administration, inadequate contributions to the development of Kampala and the rest of East Africa, what is needed is the development of refrigeration, one for practically every station, and the carriage of perishable produce in temperatures, delivery of dairy produce, meat, vegetables, poultry and all the other items of foodstuff, where the East African market is being unsatisfactory in exporting the railway system to carry out the function of the railways.

President of the committee for Kampala, M. Munro, has suggested a committee helping him put his plan into effect. He has asked Mr. R. H. Barlowes and Mr. J. D. Hartley, Directors of Barlowes and Hartley, Advertisers, sufficient to cover the cost of the plan. In addition, the plan must be put into effect from the point of view of publicised and already implemented by the Government, the development of the railway system, the production and consumption areas, and so on.
