CONFIDENT THAT EAST AFRICAN PROBLEMS WILL BE SOLVED

JAMES GRIFFITHS, Secretary of State for the Colonies, left Nairobi on his way to East Africa and was due to arrive in London on Monday. Before leaving Nairobi he was seen by the East African Standard reporter for a short time to make a statement on Kenya's political and constitutional problems. He had had full discussions with the members of the Legislative Council and the Executive Council before leaving Nairobi. He said he was confident from the talks he had had that he would be able to find a solution to the constitutional and political problems on the basis of cooperation between all concerned.

Mr. Griffiths said the clear impression was that the Government had planned to meet the wishes and the legitimate needs of the African people. He said that the Government had been successful in its efforts to bring about a clear understanding of the situation and the Government's proposals.



OUTSIDER WINS FILLIES' DERBY

Neusham Belle takes Oaks comfortably

THE last of the fillies' classics—the 17th renewal of the Oaks Stakes—was won by an outsider over the Derby course yesterday afternoon, the joint favourite being third of sixteen runners. Victory went to Major Lord Holliday's bay filly Neusham Belle (Neuro-Phase) trained by G. Brooke and ridden by N. Clayton, this 36-1 outsider having gained a very easy four-length victory over Chaise Craker and last-placed, made-up ground runner Belle of All the Thousand Guineas number.

Chaise Craker, a veteran filly by Duke-May Wing, owned by Mr. H. B. Hastings, started at 100-1 and finished two lengths ahead of the 100-100 runner Belle of All the Thousand Guineas, ridden by Captain Elliot. This fillet's unbeaten career had commenced with Sea Pearl at 100-1.

The odds were 100-1 over China Sarah, owned by Lester Piggott, and 100-100 over Harry. Harry started 100-100 and finished 100-100. The winner's margin of 11 lengths over the second-placed runner, Chaise Craker, was the largest since 1955 when Derby was won by a margin of 12 lengths.

Record stakes

A new record in Derby was set yesterday when the total prize fund for the 100-100 runner Neusham Belle was £11,000. This was the highest prize fund in the history of the race, which is held annually on the 3rd July at Epsom.

Two were left

When the gates were opened on the Oaks Stakes, 16 fillies were in the field. After a hard running, only two were left at the end of the race. Neusham Belle and Chaise Craker were the only two to finish the race.

Won unchallenged

Nothing could check Neusham Belle, however, who was unchallenged from Chinese Craker and Belle of All the Thousand Guineas. The race was won by a margin of 11 lengths.

Analyst's tests on Derby runner

Analyst's tests on the Derby runner Neusham Belle have shown that she is a very fast filly. The tests showed that she has a very high heart rate and a very high oxygen consumption.

NEW RAILWAY SURVEY ON WAY

Announcement from London TO DETERMINE BEST ROUTE FOR RHODESIA-EAST AFRICA LINK

NEW survey to determine the best route for a railway link between Rhodesia and East African ports to be held in London, it was announced in London by the Economic Cooperation Administration (Marshall Plan) mission to the United Kingdom. The survey is a joint project of the Economic Cooperation Administration and the British Colonial Office and is part of the Joint Transport and Communications Survey which was announced in October.

The announcement, declared in the survey, is to be completed by a British firm of consulting engineers in cooperation with the Government of Rhodesia and the Government of East Africa. The survey team will be headed by Sir John Stansfeld, British Consul-General in Salisbury, Rhodesia, and will include a Rhodesian and an African representative.

The survey will be completed by the end of 1951 and will be reported to the Economic Cooperation Administration. It will be the first of a series of surveys to be carried out in the region.
