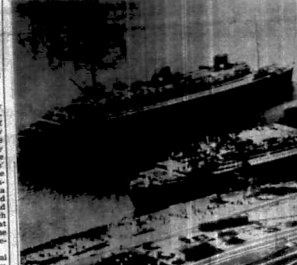
#### Available R.A.F. Aid

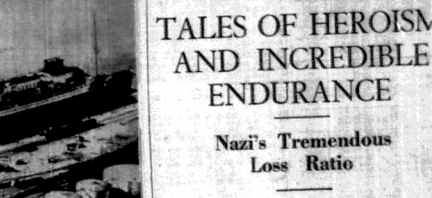

## SLIGHT AIR RAIDS ON BRITAIN THIRD QUIET NIGHT IN SUCCESSION

March 24

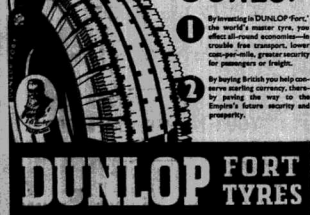

## REMINGTON CUP FINAL REPLAY

### Nairobi Win By Odd Goal In Five

Nairobi secured their fifth win in the Remington Cup competition by beating Central Kavirondo by an odd goal in five on Monday evening. The match was a regular and took place at the Nairobi Native Stadium. Saturday's game having resulted in a goalless draw after two periods of extra time.

This competition, a knock-out for the African continent, is always popular. Nairobi's previous wins were in 1936, 1937 and 1938 and Central Kavirondo won in 1939.

His Excellency the Governor, Sir Henry Moore, again attended, and, as on Saturday, there was a very large crowd of spectators. After the game His Excellency presented the Cup and medals to the winning team.

Central Kavirondo took the field and defended the Prieston's end of the Stadium and Nairobi attacked from the back. Ahmed, the centre-forward, started the ball rolling and, working his way through, passed to the outside-right, who scored a corner by a defending back. From the corner kick, Ahmed again scored, but his shot was just wide of the post.

All at once, Nairobi scored from the half-way line, but Central Kavirondo left wing away with a successful free. The latter cut and shot hard, Central Kavirondo's goalkeeper being unable to save and clearing will down the field.

Central Kavirondo's centre-half then tried to get his forwards moving but his pass to the wing went wide of play.

After ten minutes' play Nairobi scored their first goal.

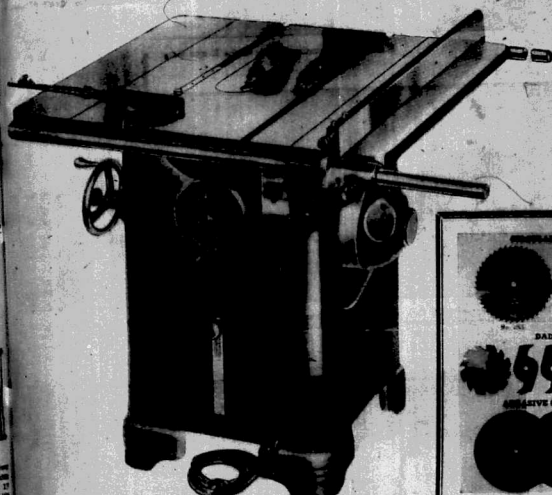

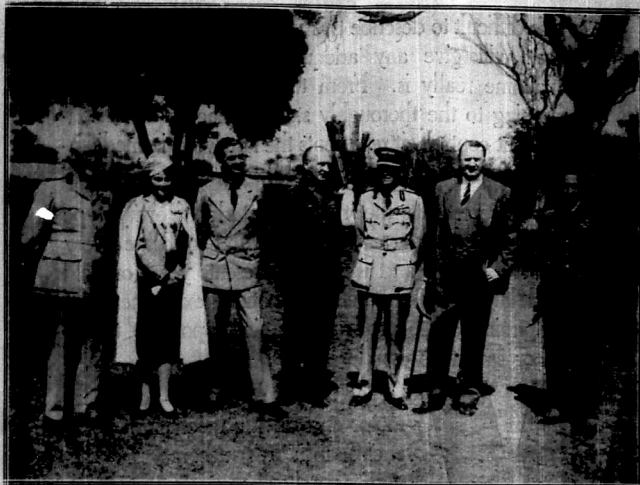

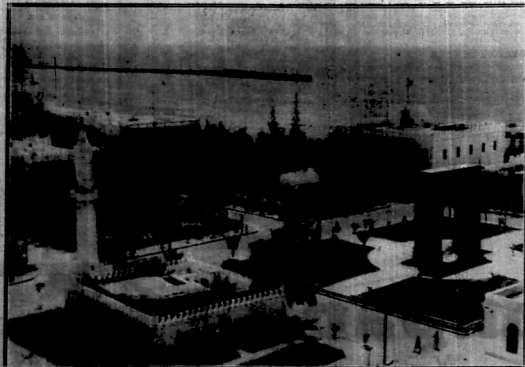

SOUTH AFRICAN SCENE:

THE RETURN OF TWO AFRIKANERS

JOHANNESBURG.

ONE of the most important events of recent weeks in South Africa has been the return to politics of General Hertzog and Mr. Havenga who were elected chief leader and deputy leader respectively of the newly formed Afrikaner Party at a congress at Bloemfontein on March 6.

It was 66 years certain at the time of writing whether General Hertzog would accept the post or not, but the definite return of Mr. Havenga is in itself an event of sufficient significance. The manner of his recall was strange. He had addressed the congress in the morning and had said that he was not returning to politics. In the afternoon, when the congress made the election, Mr. Hertzog was taking his ease in the Bloemfontein Club. After the congress had come to its decision, several delegates went out to look for him, and when they found him, they thrust their hands upon his shoulders and carried him to the club. The position of the Afrikaner Party is roughly that it supports General Smuts in everything but his war policy. Its independence from the point of view of racial concentration, is that it is opposed to the extreme Nationalism of the Nationalist and especially to their "Ein Volk" theory. 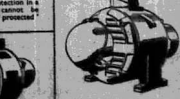
