BRAVE NIGERIAN BATTALIONS
IN THE ABYSSINIA
 How stiff opposition Was Overcome On Way To Harar
CONFIDENCE IN SOUTH AFRICAN ARTILLERY

(From Our Special Correspondent, George Kincaid, with the East African Staff.)
 Harar, March 27.
 An opportunity of paying tribute to the Nigerian who came to East Africa to fight for the British Empire, this is the second time they have done so and loyally and gallantly they fought in Transvaal.

Now I have seen them in action on several occasions, including the East African Force all the way from several columns, including the main force, and still going forward with the same tenacity and spirit as they showed at the beginning. The Nigerians were the first troops to see the advance. Now they have been the first infantry units to go into the country of Abyssinia, having fought the last seven weeks of the most difficult and dangerous of modern warfare and the deadly advantages of the machine-gun and the artillery.

On February 23, that is just over a month ago, a Battalion of the 1st Nigerians, under the command of the Major at Mafeking to take the high ground, and on the following day the remainder of the Battalion moved on to the left of the main force, and in the afternoon they were attacked by a strong Italian group and an engagement which lasted two hours.

They had to do with many Somali and Italian troops, and the British and South African units were attacked by their petrol drums and their supplies. Some time later the Nigerians were ordered to take the high ground for the first phase of the attack on Harar. This they were the first of Nigerian troops to do. The night of March 28th information was received to the effect that the 1st Nigerians had been ordered to go on to Harar. On arrival at Jijiga petrol was sent out and contact was made with the enemy in the Mafinga Pass, the first phase of the advance. The pass was found to be strongly held, and a halt was called until further reinforcements arrived, including the artillery which was still proceeding along the road from Magdala. On the night of March 28th information was received to the effect that the 1st Nigerians had been ordered to go on to Harar. On arrival at Jijiga petrol was sent out and contact was made with the enemy in the Mafinga Pass, the first phase of the advance. The pass was found to be strongly held, and a halt was called until further reinforcements arrived, including the artillery which was still proceeding along the road from Magdala.

To Magdala
 The Nigerians crossed the river and went to Gelilo, which had been captured by the Gold Coast that morning, they set out on the long trail that led with such difficulties to Magdala. About 24 miles out of Gelilo they met the South African Force, who had crossed the river lower down at Jette, and the advance proceeded without interruption, except such as was provided by heavy losses and minor interruptions, until at Harar they camped for the night.

Starting before dawn on the 21st, they made for Gelilo by way of Mofin. The day was uneventful, but not on February 22, when a squadron of the East African Crossed-Corps Regiment, with the Nigerians ran into a minefield and under heavy fire from the Italian infantry were deployed and after they had been driven back by enemy forces back, enabling the engineers to clear a path for the main force, which could again move ahead. About four miles further on the armour was engaged under artillery fire from Italian positions, just outside of Harar. The day was uneventful, but not on February 22, when a squadron of the East African Crossed-Corps Regiment, with the Nigerians ran into a minefield and under heavy fire from the Italian infantry were deployed and after they had been driven back by enemy forces back, enabling the engineers to clear a path for the main force, which could again move ahead.

Crack Battalion
 Subsequent information, which is able to reveal, shows that the 1st Nigerians were ordered to go on to Harar. On arrival at Jijiga petrol was sent out and contact was made with the enemy in the Mafinga Pass, the first phase of the advance. The pass was found to be strongly held, and a halt was called until further reinforcements arrived, including the artillery which was still proceeding along the road from Magdala.

Met Head-On
 As the main force went through Vittorio and there took place one of the straight engagements of the Mogadishu march. A road cut in on the left of the advance, it came from the right of the road and the mounted cars were in the British way, leaving to the left. As the columns moved side by side the East African armoured cars were ordered to take the side of the Italian. Many horses joined in the attack, and the Italian force was knocked out. The enemy machine-guns were destroyed and the material was captured and the enemy left heavily in rear as well.

On the following day the Nigerians were the first to see the advance. Now they have been the first infantry units to go into the country of Abyssinia, having fought the last seven weeks of the most difficult and dangerous of modern warfare and the deadly advantages of the machine-gun and the artillery.

Huns To Live Up To Their Name

Mr. Robert Fraser, in the course of a B.B.C. commentary today, points out that many people among the civilized nations think of Hitler's latest aggression, He said:—
"That shocking order of Hitler to his troops to run riot against Yugoslavia—that Berlin threat to shoot down the Serbs in the ratio of 10 to one—the bombing of the open town of Belgrade—all go to show one thing—Hitler is in one of his flaming moods; he is white with rage and wild might be he! Yugoslavia refused to let country troops be a demoral for the advancing troops to enjoy their booty on the retreat; the compromised peace Hitler calmly arranged for her and she let it plainly be known that the British Empire and her Allies are going to win the war! And worst of all; most gallant of all the British Empire troops and the British Empire troops are back again in Europe with fresh vigour, and with the same old courage, the same old spirit and the same old endurance!"

The Axis Plan
This was the Axis plan last autumn and as I enumerate the points and you compare them with the news that you have heard, you can see for yourself how plainly Hitler's Empire has already speedily broken down. His grand strategy was this: Beginning last autumn Hitler's plan was a great attack on British life launched, you know, last August by the German Air Force. His plan was to smash the Royal Air Force after the invasion of the Crimea. Half fill small paper baking cases with the mixture and bake in a moderately hot oven 42° F. for 10 to 15 minutes.

Technique Of Film Education

SUCCESSFUL TOURS BY KENYA UNIT

The Mobile Cinema Van in the charge of Mr. Champion has just returned from yet another most successful tour of the provinces. This time, this comprising in some eight months the round of the Native Reserves of the Colony.

FANTASTIC SCENES IN ADDIS ABABA

(Continued from page 1)

They were attacked en route by Abyssinian soldiers. Eight hundred million lire went in to make on Friday the Bank of Italy made a bonfire of notes in the courtyard of the currency office to prevent the currency from falling into the hands of the enemy. 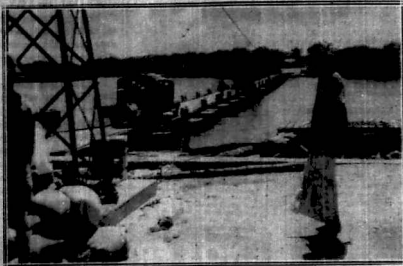

The Grand Strategy of War

THE STRATEGY of Europe (as Hannon W. Baldwin pointed out in a recent copy of the New York Times Magazine) is the strategy of geography, raw materials and terrain. It is the immutable strategy of woods and oil and coal and bauxite, of distances and mountains, forests and plains, of the basins and Birmingham, where the machines of men make the machines of war. It is the strategy of mountain ranges and of great river systems; the strategy of seas and rivers.

In the tremendous drama played over the theatre of Europe, now approaching a climax, Germany enjoys the advantage of what is known as military parlance as an "interior position." As a situation of war, at the centre of a circle, and can enjoy more forces, men and planes, over its interior lines of transportation than the rest of that circle, any sector or sector, whereas Great Britain must move her forces by long exterior lines along the perimeter of the circle. Consequently, the British, who are flung like a ball on the coast of Western Europe, are favourably situated to facilitate sea blockades and Britain's possession of Gibraltar and Berber locks the Mediterranean. 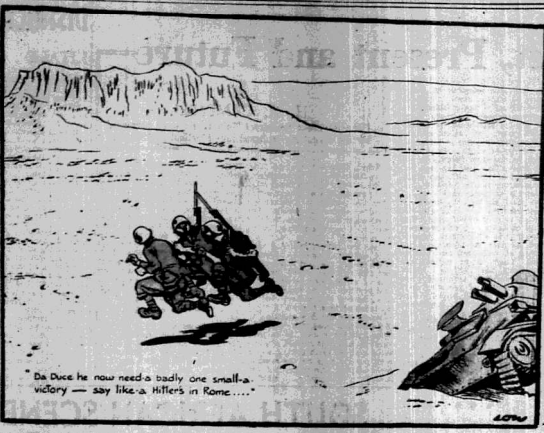

Germany, operating upon its interior lines of communication, cannot with greater speed move against the bases of Britain's power in the sea. There are basic strategic factors. The conflict is a struggle for a great sea and air power. Britain, with a great land and air power—Germany, with Italy, is in a subordinate role. The loss of sea power for Germany is a continent and crush the power of the continent of the Axis. CONVERSATION PIECE

"One must be able to grasp that the correct way to prosecute war is not to follow the course of events, but to forestall them." — DEMOSTRATIONS.

As I write this piece, I have just read the British newspaper account of the making of the British offensive in the Balkans. The news has been announced that our Forces—imperial and South African—have entered the capital, Albania, our Forces have reached Addis Ababa. Here is history, so hot and fresh that as yet we do not know the names by which this campaign will go down to future generations, and it will not be long now until the end of the campaign in Africa. It was only about Christmas time that soldiers told me they would be by Easter, and then, though I did not contradict them, I did not think it could be so.

History is an absorbing story, except perhaps to small boys who have it forced upon them, and there are many ways of making acquaintance with it. There is the textbook, dry, dusty, but authoritative; the biography of the great men, who have helped to make it; the historical novel and play, and nowadays, one must add, the historical film. But of all these, the raw material of history as chronicled from day to day in the newspapers brings an atmosphere of liveliness and urgency which transports one into the feeling of the times in a way that no textbook can. Perhaps the explanation is better found in the fact that whereas the book accounts are set down carefully at a distance of time when events have shaped themselves and fallen into place in the pattern of history, the contemporary writings in newspapers are always able to communicate to the reader that sense of excitement associated with the term "latest news," and the actual spirit of the events which are not yet aware of the significance of the facts which are yet to be revealed.

But what surprised me more than the psycho-logical anything was the public apathy towards this war of our campaign, apart from the bells on Sunday night, there was no other sign of recognition and rejoicing in the streets, no public holiday, no celebrations on the following day. And surely it is surprising that the crisis of our triumph, should not be made public until the formal announcement had been made from London—over twenty-four hours after it must have been known by the authorities in Nairobi. It has been a great achievement in so short a time and surely deserves the best sort of publicity, particularly in this country of mixed races. As soon as I myself heard the announcement, I told the houseboys what had happened and they were as glad and excited as I, laughing and chattering and pointing their hands; this sort of thing is something that only those who are not in it, something they can understand, but it is the truth. The authorities, Military, Government and Civil, have shown, to my mind, singular abnegation in not recognizing the psychological moment for display—on one occasion on which we might legitimately show our triumph. Maybe they are waiting till the complete capture of Albania but that is likely to be a draw-out affair, less easily understandable than the occupation of a capital, and by then, too, public interest will no doubt have shifted to events in the Balkans.

British "pragmatism" is all very well when things are bad, but how that they are good, that we in East Africa and in South Africa, too—have been saved from the threefold bombing, machine and invasion, occasion with rejoicing, a symbol of our thanks to the Forces.

After all, news in wartime has not opened up very much. It is interesting to read in the 1939 anniversary edition of Berrow's Worcester Journal the British newspaper in Britain that they had been sent to the front only four days after the outbreak, though at that time it was not fully appreciated that this was the end of the campaign. On the other hand, the outspokenness and lack of propaganda of any modern campaign have brought news to the eyes of British Africa. GERMANY REACHES SAONICA

Heroic Greek Resistance In Struma Valley TERRIFIC MECHANISED ATTACK

HITLER this morning ordered that Germany was at war with Yugoslavia only a few hours after it had been announced from Moscow that a treaty of friendship had been signed between Yugoslavia and the Soviet.

Since then German broadcasts have stated that the German army has already started to attack Yugoslavia and Greece.

"The Greeks have been misled by the British propaganda machine. No news of any direct steps to their help have been received up to this afternoon, but it is reported that two large German divisions have been sent to the Balkans. The German Minister in Rome today said that the German army had already started to attack Yugoslavia and Greece. The German Government of having abandoned neutrality in 1939.

The Munich Treaty
