LABOUR LAWS OF KENYA

Review For Benefit Of Employers

THE KENYA INDUSTRY OFFICE has issued the following statement on Kenya labour conditions. At a time when employers are appreciative of labour conditions, it may be as well to review the labour laws which will be in force today. It is not possible to touch on every detail of the laws which are spread over the Employment of Domestic Servants and the Industrial Disputes Act, but the most important provisions are outlined below. The Industrial Disputes Act, which is applied to employers and employees, is contained in the Industrial Disputes Act, 1920. Every action over the age of sixteen years should have a Registration Certificate which is issued by the Registrar of Industrial Disputes when seeking employment. If his certificate shows he is not to be discharged by his previous employer, he may not be engaged, even on a casual labour. If the certificate is in order, he may be signed on or engaged by the day as a casual labour.

In certain cases, in addition to the Registration Certificate, every Domestic Servant must be in possession of a 'red book', i.e. a Fingerprint Register issued under the provisions of the Domestic Servants Ordinance. This must be signed on as well as the Registration Certificate and the book must be forwarded to the nearest Registrar of Domestic Servants, together with a stamp for purposes of recording the registration. These red books must be produced in registration over by employers in domestic employment, or domestic servants. Furthermore, during the time that when in the district where the Domestic Servants Ordinance is in force, if a servant is in possession of a 'red book' must be retained in the same way as if he were employed in any other way.

Every male who is a registered domestic servant has his registration certificate a rubber-stamped document. The Registrar of Domestic Servants will issue a 'red book' if his certificate is not stamped or if it is stamped and he cannot produce a 'red book'. Further enquiries should be made before employing him.

If and when a native is engaged, an official contract must be drawn up and handed to the Registrar of Industrial Disputes. This contract is obtainable free from the Labour Department, which will also issue a Form No. 1, which is a declaration report on a labour contract. It is a mandatory document only. Official complaints forms can be obtained from the Labour Department or any Labour Officer's office.

Employment of juveniles, no person may employ a juvenile under 14 years of age, if he has to stay away from his home; his age limit will be increased to 16 years when the Employment of Juveniles (Amendment) Ordinance, 1939, is brought into operation, but it is noted that in the Municipality of Nairobi it is an offence to employ a juvenile under 14 years of age.

Leave Conditions. Leave by one month may be granted to a servant on a ticket, or monthly, or special contract, but leave certificate must be given to the employer by an employer as soon as possible. PLATEAU PYRETHRUM GROWERS

District Association Formed

A well-attended and successful meeting of registered pyrethrum growers in the Kisumu and districts was held on Wednesday last, April 23, at the Pioneer Hotel, Nairobi. Some fifty growers, representative of about 5,000 acres of pyrethrum, were present.

The first resolution to be passed at a preliminary meeting was— That this meeting of registered pyrethrum growers forming in the District and Nairobi districts is in favour of forming a District Pyrethrum Association to ensure that its views may be represented to the Pyrethrum Board of Kenya. This resolution was carried in unison.

After a ballot, the following were chosen to represent the Association: Major R. Kuperus (Chairman), Messrs. L. M. Wellwood (Kilipaka area), B. Mosey (Athika), G. F. Marsh (Lindi), T. Lowe (Plateau), A. Wright (Mombasa), and E. G. Meyers (Nairobi Farms District), with Mrs. M. Durovi as Hon. Secretary and Treasurer. Lady Elizabeth Wellwood acted as Secretary for the purpose of the meeting and the registered committee meeting.

Supervisory Agents The agenda included some ten desirable subjects covering production of acreage and output, suggestions for furthering the present position and other matters. The Chairman extended a welcome to Mr. W. Trench, who attended the meeting by invitation representing the Pyrethrum Board of Kenya, and as each item on the agenda was discussed open for debate. Mr. Trench was invited to put his views before the meeting and these were followed by considerable discussion. At the end of a particularly interesting meeting, the newly-appointed district committee met and completed a memorandum covering the points of view expressed during discussion and the resolutions carried by the meeting. 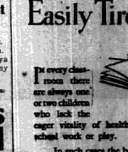
POPPY DAY COLLECTION

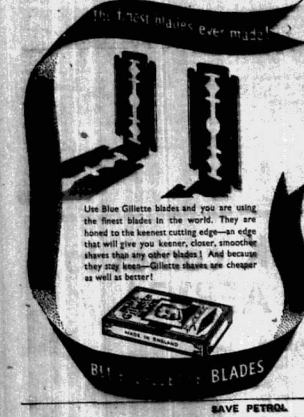

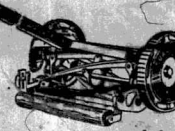

MUNICIPAL BREVITIES

Various resolutions and committee recommendations were adopted without debate at Tuesday's meeting of the Nairobi Municipal Council. These included the following:

It was decided to recommend to the Director of Education that an application to open a kindergarten school in Yendi Road, Morningside, should be granted.

The General Manager, V.M.B. and H.L. is to be asked to sanction the establishment of a Municipal beer shop in the Railway Station. It was suggested that this was desirable in order to combat brewing and the purchase of illicit liquor by British and native employees.

A recommendation that a proposal to reconstitute the Finance Commission was not adopted was approved by Council. It had been suggested that Council's Finance Committee should consist of the Chairman of the Finance Commission and the Mayor and Deputy Mayor ex-officio members.

The question of street lighting is to be further considered and a report from the Municipal Engineer is to be called for on the progress of Council's street lighting programme. This had to be suspended at the outbreak of the war. It was proposed, but a suggestion that a certain area should be considered separately was not approved.

Recommendations regarding changes in street names were adopted. The name of the portion of Swamep Road, between the intersection of Forest Road, is to be changed to Langata Road. The portion of Hill Road between Government Hill and Forest Road is to be changed to Forest Road.

Council is to continue to pay the difference between the ordinary rates of pay of members of their staff on Military rates and the amounts they received from the Army by way of pay and allowances.

By-laws amending the schedule of licence fees for hand carts, making substantial reductions for three or four wheeled rubber-tired carts, were approved and passed. By-laws relating to cinders in roadside drains were also passed.

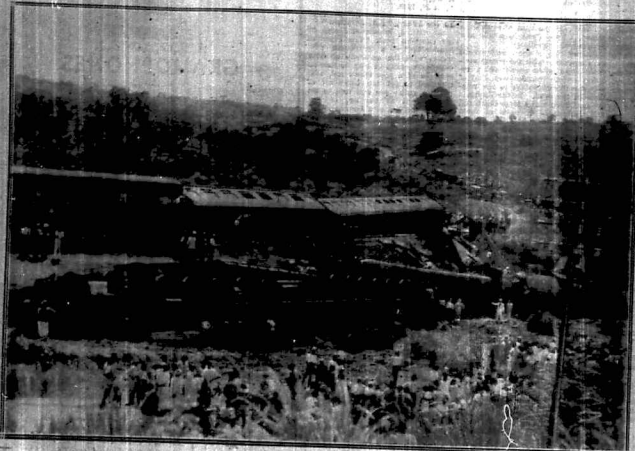

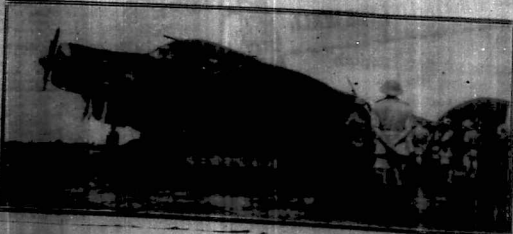
