By giving part of the work to be contracted, it appears that in each case the quotation of the Government printer has been considerably less and on the whole, it does not appear to Sir Alan Pim that economy would be secured. However, savings may be effected through the standardization of the forms required for Government notices and remarks that while the majority of annual reports have been reduced to reasonable length, some include a good deal of propaganda and account of scientific investigations.

Annual reports, he says, are largely the work of the Government printer, but it is of great importance that the Government Printer, at present vacant, should be selected. There will be a saving of £1,040.

**Prisoners**

Turning to the Prison Department the Report remarks that the Commissioner of Prisons last year stated on examining the present number of European officers and their emoluments as he holds that only in this way it is possible to combine efficiency with economy. Sir Alan Pim goes on to say that the development of the prison population and the expansion of the work of the department by any corresponding development in the number of the prisoners. Both the accommodation and the scope of prison activities are very limited. In the Colony's 12 detentive camps discipline is necessarily lax and little work done. The defects in the existing system lie in the character of the buildings, in the communication between all officers and first offenders, in the method of dealing with prisoners and the industries or other labour provided. These however, are matters not of economy but of additional expenditure.

As regards economy if the prison population remains at the present level, a number of wardens can be reduced. There appeared to be 25 over strength at the time of Sir Alan Pim's investigation. Consideration might also be given to the reduction of the family allowances of the department to reduce the cost of the staff. First offenders could be put into these farm camps, receive partial training and be effectively segregated from the recidivists, where put forward to the Commissioner of Prisons. Sir Alan to exercise careful consideration. Under it, the department would concentrate more closely on the first and second class prisoners while the third class prisoners would be placed under the officers of the administration with staffs recruited on the lines of the tribal police. 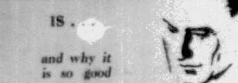

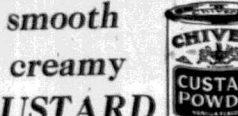

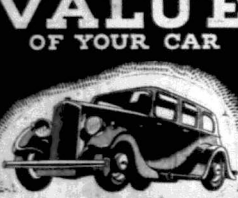

**"EAR" FOR CAR NOISES**

**Experiment by Ministry of Transport**

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.]

London.

The Ministry of Transport is, it is understood, considering the use of the "electric ear" for the measurement of car noise.

The new instrument is based on a specially constructed set of plates of varying thickness and shape of varying radii, which are held in position by a spring mechanism. It is held in position by the Ministry and will be used for the measurement of car noise.

The object is to obtain exact information as to how the regular noise produced by the various machines in a motor would work on the ear.

Two tests are proposed—one a normal running test, the other a "revving up" test to be made in low speed in the open end of the exhaust. Hitherto, however, there has been no scientific method of measuring the noise produced. This point has been emphasized in the course of recent discussions between the Ministry and manufacturers and it is generally supposed that the new test will be a watershed.

Later, it is possible that general car noise regulations may be brought into force. Control of the noise level permissible in new cars will, however, come first.

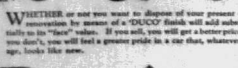

SOUTH AFRICA'S GREAT EXHIBITION

TO BE OPENED TO-DAY BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL

Following many months of intensive preparation the great Empire exhibition at Johannesburg will be officially opened to-day by the Governor General (Lord Curzon).

Such is the attraction of the exhibition—the first of its kind to be held outside the British Isles—that it is expected that thousands of people all over the world will have to travel to South Africa recently, and will continue to do so during the next few months, while it is thought that at least one million will pay for admission during the event.

The idea for the exhibition was first conceived in 1914 when it was suggested that the Empire Exhibition should be merged for an Empire exhibition with a section of Johannesburg's Jubilee. The proposal was put forward by the Federation of British Industries, and a Chamber of Commerce, which took the lead in offering a sum of £50,000 towards expenses.

After an additional attraction during the next month, four months of the exhibition will be an amazingly beautiful picture. Various structures will house the exhibits of the different Dominions and of the South African Government—erected at a cost of £500,000—the largest building on the Exhibition grounds. It is that of the British Government, which houses the exhibits of the Kingdoms of Kenya, Tanganyika, and Zanzibar have come to the exhibition in a special pavilion, and here one may see the exhibits of the various countries of the British Empire.

The main objects of the exhibition are to give the history of the Empire and to promote friendly relations between the various parts of the Empire. It is also intended to popularize the Empire and to give world-wide publicity to the Union, and to give other parts of the Empire an opportunity of showing the products which have taken place in their respective countries.

That done, the Elected Members have an immense responsibility of the "temporary" taxes, (a) gradual reduction of protecting duties, and when the finances of the Colony permit, and (b) the reduction of the Government of the economy proposals of the Pim Report.

I draw particular attention to (b). If Captain Schwartz is more concerned with trying to make a Income Tax than with securing reductions in the gross national product, he will argue that imposition of pre-progressive taxes like the introduction of Income Tax should be simultaneous, but he is not, he will acknowledge that over and over again the Elected Members have endorsed the principle of "Balancing the Budget and of retrenching surplus, balance, and cannot, therefore, ask Government for tax reductions in the coming year in excess of the amount made good by Income Tax.

In writing the above I am not unmindful of the fact that although my income is rated at the value of my Naval pension on which a 10 per cent tax is levied, I pay no indirect taxes to Government in addition to Customs and Excise duty and about £100 per annum subscription to the sphere of Government services, the total sum of which would produce a net amount the economy of any other citizen, thus "over-acting Africa."

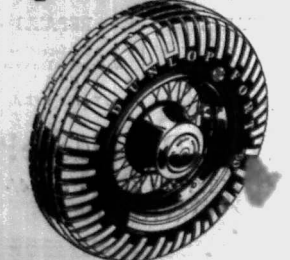

£150 REWARD IF HE SUCCEEDED IN SHOOTING HIS MAJESTY

Incredible Tale

ACCUSED ASKS FOR HEAVIEST SENTENCE AS A PROTECTION

An amazing story of having been hired by the agents of a foreign power to shoot the King with a view to the breaking up of the British Empire was told by the man, McMahon, charged in connexion with the revolver incident as the King was returning from presenting Colours.

The accused said he had been endeavouring to reveal the plot to the authorities and carried the revolver because he was afraid of the people who employed him.

He expressed the hope that he would receive the heaviest sentence the Court could award since that would be the only means of saving his life.

The Attorney General suggested that the story told by the prisoner was simply the product of McMahon's imagination and the Judge was of the opinion that what had been done was simply with a view to gaining notoriety. His Lordship was satisfied McMahon never had any intention of harming the King.

Sent to Prison for a Year

McMahon was sentenced to a year in prison for a year. The judge said that McMahon was a man of low character and that he had been hired to shoot the King. McMahon was found guilty of an attempt to murder the King and was sentenced to a year in prison.
