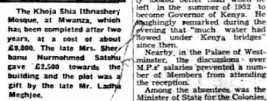

While I was Governor of Kenya I made many representations to be allowed, when before the House of Commons, to take the sort of powers the House of Commons had granted the United Kingdom in wartime to detain dangerous persons, but without success. The most we were able to obtain as a concession was that we might inquire before judge or magistrate which had been convicted.

FEARLY next year, food production in East Africa may be facing the most serious threat it has known for years. Its economy may receive a severe setback and whether or not catastrophe will hit an depends to a large extent on a body of men who have so far been able to slave it off.

The catastrophe, if it comes, will be in the form of locusts—millions of them, covering many square miles and darkening the sky as they settle on crops and grazing. After a six-year lull against the present plague locusts, creatures seen to have taken the upper hand and experts have told me, huge swarms are already on their way from breeding grounds in Arabia. They may be expected to meet other big plagues which may form in the Somali Peninsula between October and December this year and by Dec. 20 to East Africa.

So is that what we have to contend with.

Constant threat

DESERT Locust Control, with its headquarters in London, is already conducting an intense campaign in the Somali Peninsula, but experts fear the locusts may swarm there in such great numbers that the men fighting them may be unable to cope.

To look at a locust is an ineffective enough creature. About three inches long with spiky legs and a lustrous, brown body, it appears harmless, and is when alone. But in numbers locusts have a constant threat to mankind, from time immemorial.

Locusts can be made to fly by suspending them from a wire frame hung from a central pivot. Feeling themselves suspended in mid-air they begin to fly and turn the roundabout. In this way some estimate of speed and duration of flight can be made.

Congress war has been waged against them for centuries. Time and again they have dropped from the sky in their millions to attack some desolate area, leaving behind them ravages, crop, starvation and often consequent death. We are lucky, in fact, to be able to state their way through every country. Modern scientific methods have reduced the damage, but still the creatures are a scourge to man and even now we cannot always deal with them.

Lives risked

EAST AFRICA has suffered before. In Tanganyika in 1929 and 1930 and the first cent of crops there were lost according to reports on his talks with locust experts and tells us that in British areas where research is constantly going on to help in fighting the scourge from the desert.

a world authority on locusts, Dr. B. P. Uvayrov, in Kenya in 1911 they ruined 20 per cent of maize in European East Africa, while grazing suffered so heavily the milk yield fell by 50 per cent.

In the present plague, which began in Arabia in 1948, East Africa has paid about £2,000,000, and the £1,000,000 spent in men and material in the last three years. In the same old story, it is estimated that costing millions in man and material have literally risked their lives.

Once locusts have grown into the flying stage they are a real scourge of the world and at their disposal. The species that threaten Kenya is the Desert Locust, which also threatens the whole of Africa north of the equator, the entire Middle East, Persia, Syria, Southern Russia, Iraq, India and Afghanistan.

Voracious

SWARMS of Desert Locusts covering 100 square miles have been found. The average swarm covers very roughly 20 square miles and contains between 500,000,000 and 1,000,000,000 locusts, each weighing about a tenth of an ounce. A single swarm can weigh thousands of tons ... and can cause a loss of up to 100 per cent of crop and stock in open vegetation.

Swarms have been found more than 100 miles long and 100 miles wide. Depending on the wind they may travel about 10 miles a day and may remain in the same area for months, from when they hatch to when they are dispersed. The result is a trail of potential plague swarms.

Desert Locusts may lay in great numbers in the form of the Red Valley Nymphs and Turkeys in Kenya.

make it a breeding ground. It does not migrate in any chosen direction. It is carried by winds and is blown through by the north-east monsoon.

Mystery

SEVERAL things about the locusts are still mystery. Nobody knows exactly why they swarm and stick to their course. One of the biggest difficulties is to find out why a locust will begin to fly. It is not clear why they are drawn together and banded in swarms. After annual weather there—such as a cyclone or such causes rain, then start on their breeding.

The burden

DESERT Locust Control is not confined to East Africa, but is also in Ethiopia and the Somali Peninsula. Until this year Desert Locust Control has been shouldering the major burden of fighting locusts in the control of the present plague. This year, however, it is simple, could not cope with the expense and had to shut down its work here. That is largely why the big and uncontrolled swarms are travelling south.

Attempts have been made by various countries for years to control locusts by their insecticide answer to all plagues. The first really organized attempt was made recently when the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations gave \$200,000 to the fight and the teams from the various nations to work

Few swarms

MANS chief weapon is poison. Desert Locust Control, for example, is equipped with seven spraying aircraft with 100 vehicles and has a fleet of about 180. Their primary job is to prevent locusts entering East Africa in such great numbers that they can seriously threaten the economy. They control always prevent locusts to individual farmers. The Control is at present fighting swarms travelling south from Turkana, one of which covers 24 square miles. Swarms covering the track of the Nile are very big.

Swarms are used at D.C. and B.I.C. They are sprayed. Being right through them, locusts are swarms across rugged country in a single hour. Hoppers are killed by placing bromocresol blue in their path.

One gallon of poison sprayed from the air is estimated to kill about 300,000 locusts. The aircraft used by the Desert Locust Control can carry between 100 and 150 gallons each. If the huge swarms covering the Nile can carry between 100 and 150 gallons each, it will take very large numbers of flights to kill them.

Locusts eggs are affixed the size of a wheat seed, laid in batches of 40-100 at one time in moist sand in a penicillin-burrow. A fly-like substance holds them and the same grass is eaten. One female lays an average of more than 200 eggs. Ten days after being laid the eggs hatch.

together. The attempt fails. It is difficult to say why probably because of lack of money, equipment and men. There are also the natural difficulties of working in the vast spaces of Arabia—and the diagnostic methods that have to be used by many of the inhabitants that have to be used as an Act of God and not to be interfered with.

How much?

In a real emergency, several millions were spent on equipment, aircraft, laying off stocks of poison and employing staff, what would happen if at the last minute the swarms changed direction and completely bypassed East Africa? We would be left with too many locusts to be completely maintained, but only used for a part of the year. Even if the swarms did not, we would still be left with all the aircraft and equipment to maintain.

Desert Locust Control is always being blamed for spending too much money when there are no locusts in East Africa, and for not spending enough when they are about. But are not the chief moving staff towards East Africa, and they are not the only ones who have to be kept in the area and again by keeping locusts out.

THE PRESS HUNDS HOPES OF REACHING MAKALU COL

The great mass of Makalu (27,900 ft) unquestionably dominates the Barun Valley. From our Base Camp we can see the members of the Californian expedition still doggedly attempting to scale the mountain, but their progress is pitifully slow as they struggle with the fantastic difficulties of the south ridge.

In 1952 when we entered the Barun Valley for the first time and looked at Makalu through mountain clouds Evans, Lowe and I felt that the route and perhaps the only route to the summit lay from a different direction - from the Barun side. 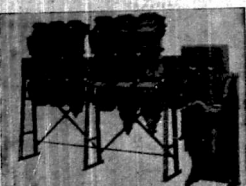

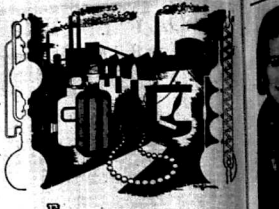

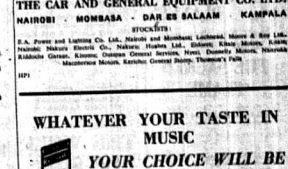

MOVES TO MEET NEED FOR TRADESMEN

It was necessary not only to make Uganda strong enough to resist but also to ensure that it had an informed public opinion with ordinary men and women, and their leaders, who are interested in the future of the country.

A MEMORANDUM showing how £2,000,000 is being spent on technical and commercial education in the Uganda Government since the year 1952-53 has been published in the "East African Standard".

Since the war, it states, the demand for skilled tradesmen in the Protectorate has increased rapidly, but at the same time the standard of craft and technical education has fallen.

The Technical Advisory Committee, set up by the Government on the recommendation of the late Sir Andrew Chibwe, recommended that 100,000 should be the lowest level of technical education, and that 300,000 should be the highest.

The memorandum states that the first three years of technical education should be spent on the study of the basic sciences and mathematics, and that the last two years should be spent on the study of a particular trade.

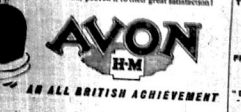
