LYTELTON PLAN CLAUSE

Five Elected Members of Kenya Legislative Council, who have been Ministers in the Government under the Lytelton Commission, yesterday (Thursday) resigned in the hands of the Governor, Sir Evelyn Baring. This announcement in an official statement issued last night from Government House, Nairobi.

The five Ministers are: Mr. M. Blundell (Agriculture), Mr. W. B. Havell (Local Government), Mr. I. E. Nathoo (Works) and Group Capt. L. R. M. Madan who have not held office since the Lytelton Commission was set up.

An announcement said that the Governor had accepted the resignations and had asked the Ministers to continue in office until such time as he is in a position to reconstitute the Government.

ELSA MAKES A SAFARI TO LAKE RUDOLF

Writing from Isaka, JOY ADAMSON describes a safari to Lake Rudolf with her Game Warden husband and their pet Howler, Elsa.

AT last everything is ready. Our five vehicles are packed with enough equipment to take us for seven weeks to Lake Rudolf where we will collect our donkey transport with which to make a foot safari from the lake.

This area is one of the remotest in the Northern Frontier Province, consisting for the most part of sand and lava desert. Our route will take us 180 miles to Marsabit and then another 150 to the lake. We are quite a party — four Europeans, 20 African game trackers, personal staff, Elsa and six live sheep to feed her on the journey.

Elsa, I feel, is somewhat lonely, whom we have raised since she was a tiny cub when her mother, a non-eater, died to be shot. She was still timid when we adopted her and we were the first living Europeans she received of the world. Since then she has accepted us as part of her pride and she goes in all the privileges and amenities she would normally expect.

EVERY COMFORT

My truck is ideally suited for her travelling as the back is a spring on box body packed with soft, lagging such as hessian wool, and the car works from a comfortable position in the driver's seat.

When we took her to the Coast on holiday the same day about returning and she always conveys in leave the sheep, often she dived off the boat, leaping along the beach. On another visit she had to cross a flooded river in my car. The car stuck halfway across, and had to be unloaded in order to tow it across. Elsa thought it all great fun and pushed into the river and swam across, splashed by a large troop of baboons.

Elsa is a good walker and we hope will also enjoy the country we enter. But it will be her first experience in the company of 15 donkeys and we can only hope that they will accept each other.

The time to start comes and we call Elsa who sleeps in the bush near our house at Isaka.

She soon appeared with her characteristic black and white patches on her face. She was sitting on a low branch, and we had to keep her inside the vehicle, as it is the only protection against the three monkeys she hates.

SADLY PLAINS

The first 180 miles over the Northern Frontier Province, through the lava desert, was mostly flat with sandy vegetation. As we walked the cool high-altitude forest of the Marsabit region and the high-altitude forest of the Marsabit region and will be cut off from contact with the outside world for the next six weeks.

We jumped into hot lava fields and my crew got stuck with the glare and dust. Nothing breaks the monotony of sand gullies and lava ridges, except a wooden cross, which nearly breaks my eye in half.

One back wheel has left us and I'm stuck in an almost bog. From Elsa I take hours to get the flames lit, required and we have to keep her inside the vehicle, as it is the only protection against the three monkeys she hates.

WATER CURE

We take Elsa to the lake and she at once rubs into the water, splashing and jumping about as if to throw off the strain of the previous stage of travelling. We try to scare away any crocodiles which there are plenty in the lake. I had searched about Elsa and the shepherds. She washes everything we do with washing water over 100 lbs donkey load.

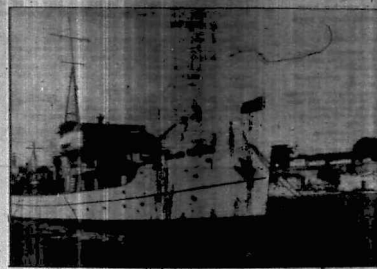

Surprise in stamps of Seychelles

By T. C. D. JONES

IF seen as a not unpleasant surprise recently to find letters from the Seychelles, franked with the current Queen Elizabeth 6-cent stamps overprinted with five cents.

This was necessary, the Queen Agents state, by reason of a shortage of two cent and three cent values while waiting for a new five cent stamp.

There was when Seychelles stamps were overprinted with a very short time of their issue. It is noted that the Queen Victoria issue of 1935 which in 1932 had served overprinted with five cents.

More overprints
These gave rise to a crop of four overprints and four double overprints later in the year but in 1936 there were two more overprints and this time overprints were double and treble.

There was another crop in 1941 (1940 and 1939) when the Queen Victoria stamps were overprinted with various overprints, inverted and horizontal.

The issue of Edward VII which gave rise to no variation while the King was in Great Britain, the introduction of postal values from 1914 to 1935, various overprints, inverted and horizontal, and some there have been no overprinted issues — until now.

Interest kept
There is little likelihood of any further overprints, but the present issue, and the issue on which the Seychelles stamps are available in the Seychelles Islands, is a very short one. The stamps may turn out to be the last of the Seychelles stamps in the immediate term "a nice little line to call away for a future time."

The Seychelles issue determined to keep interest alive for one more issue of the Queen Elizabeth definitive, we have had three more values, the two issues of Possession commemoratives and now an overprint.
