SUCCESTS SERVEDING 100 MILES OF THE TANGE TANGE TO SUIKO AND KAHE.

Mr. Roger Gibb in his recent report on railway finances does not recommend the amalgamation of the East African railway systems.

In his view the limited economies would be outweighed by the political disadvantages as it would be impossible entirely to eliminate suspicion of favoured treatment.

Discussing the problem of Tanganyika Central Railnumming the protection of Tanganyaka Central Rail-way, robbed of Congo copper traffic which will not return, Mr. Gibb looks to the encouragement of native production as the main source of im-proved revenue.

As an example of how the native should be encouraged to develop his economic wants and to satisfy them by planting larger crops, Mr. Gibb instances the use of the pedal bicycle which should not be penalised by heavy railway rates.

He adversely criticises a proposal to establish a Railway Advisory Council in Tanganyika.


