

PROTEST AGAINST ALLEGED EXCESSES.

Poland Joins Movement.

ANTI-SEMITIC ORDER BY BAVARIAN GOVERNMENT.

SATURDAY APRIL 1, 1988.

The movement to promote a boycott by Jews of German goods, as a protest against the alleged anti-semitic policy of the Nazis, is spreading. Jews in Poland have now joined the boycott. A Jewish world organisation in London also supports the movement, but another body representing Jews in the British Empire has decided not to extend its support.

It is stated in Prussia that discrimination against Jews has ceased, but on the other hand it is also announced that in Bayaria Jews have been forbidden to hold judicial office.

1932 Surprises.

DEFICIT REDUCED BY HALF AND FAVOURABLE TRADE BALANCE

A long review of the main problems now facing Kenya was provided by His Excellency the Governor, Sir Joseph Byrne in an address to Legislative Council on Wednesday.

The Governor intimated that the deficit for 1932 instead of being £220,000 as expected was only £160,000, the lowest recorded since 1978.

multaneously he was able to report that the Kenya and Uganda trade agures of the same year disclosed a favourable balance of 25.9 per cout, compared with 8.12 per cent. for leat!

It is expected that the revenue estimates for the current year will be realised.

returnent is in agreement with the general policy of reducing the number of provinces recommended by the Expenditure Advisory Committee.

The Governor intimated that he was endeavouring to obtain additional capital amounting to £260,000 for the Land Bank.

In a reference to the Budget problem His Excellency expressed the earnest hope that the debates might be free from all bitterness. "Each and all of us," he said "have the welfare of Kenya at heart."
