In fact, one of the conditions of aid from the World Bank and the I.D.A. was that the Government should have a plan to spend money on development.

Mr. Gichuru said that an important decision was taken at a meeting of the Kenya Development Council in Nairobi last week.

# U.N. will not interfere in Rhodesia

THE U.N. Security Council declined yesterday to interfere in today's scheduled elections in Rhodesia, but it called upon the British Government to begin consultations aimed at restructuring the colony's Constitution in terms acceptable to the 4,000,000 African majority.

The 11-nation council also urged London to take all necessary action to prevent the unilateral declaration of independence by the whites.

It said that the U.N. Security Council had no jurisdiction over Rhodesia, which generally claims to be a self-governing state.

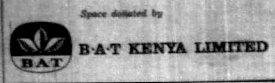
# SMILING OVER A HOT STOVE

He joined the Provincial Administration as Officer in charge of the Mts. tea area in 1951. He has been a member of the Board of the Kenya Tea Development Authority, representing Mts. tea growers of the Eastern Province. He has also been a member of the Mts. County Council.

As a tea officer, Mr. Stewart will be responsible for the collection of tea from the Mts. district and the maintenance of relations with the transporters of the tea.

## GROUP TO MARKET MEAT

A GROUP of 20 people have joined together in Nyanza to form a body called the Nyanza Animal Auctioneer and Supply.

The main object is to handle all cattle buying and selling in Nyanza and Central Nyanza. This body would make arrangements to meet the local butchers' requirements of meat and to balance the price of their stock in the market. The group is headed by Mr. S. S. Ombaka.

Already, they have over 200 head of cattle and are in possession of a lorry. It is anticipated that in the next few months the group will be able to cover the trade between Nyanza and Central Nyanza and to handle all cattle buying and selling in Nyanza and Central Nyanza.

If it proves successful, the new Nyanza meat market will bring a lot of money to the stockholders.

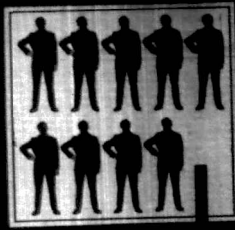


Illustration showing the effect of the 'New Arrival' on the 'Rebel Wife'.

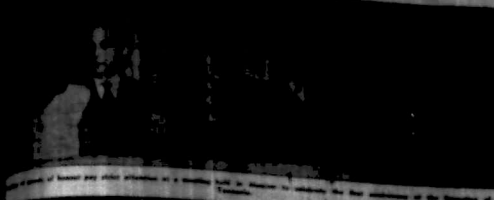

**EUROPE'S TV EXPERTS DISCUSS COLOUR**

EUROPE will not be able to enjoy colour television transmissions before 1967, even if the 200 delegates to the forthcoming conference of a special committee of the International Consulting Council for Radio-communications agree on a common system.

Experts here in contrast, including many of the United States, Japan and Australia, met in Vienna on Monday to discuss colour, if any, of the three systems under discussion.

Technicians have already agreed on many details of the Common European Colour System and all 200 delegates if the experts agree on a common system, before their decision would have to pass several other bodies before a colour television system could be set up.

Manufacture colour television receivers and transmitters very expensive, so that no one will be able to start regular colour television until the late '60s.

Technicians today are still able to solve some of the problems, but sometimes they are unable to solve several other problems. Therefore, many of the delegates to the forthcoming conference will be disappointed.




