











# Mr. Nehru extends his visit to Nigeria by one day

INDIA Prime Minister, Mr. Nehru, who is visiting Nigeria on his way back from the Commonwealth Prime Ministers Conference in London, is staying an extra day in Lagos after the postponement of his visit to Accra. The Indian ambassador here said he would leave for Lagos on Friday morning, arriving there on Friday afternoon and would go to Accra on Saturday. He had been scheduled to visit Lagos after leaving Ghana.

## CRITICISM OF GHANA IN INDIAN PRESS

THE independent Hindustan Times described the expulsion of Mr. Nehru's visit to Ghana as an embarrassing admission of the prevailing insecurity in the country. Mr. Nehru's three-day visit to Ghana has been described as the state of emergency declared in the Accra area last week. In an editorial the newspaper said: "President Nkrumah's visit to Ghana is a sign of the growing insecurity in African states and a warning to their wayward Parliamentary democracy." The independent Indian Express said: "Nothing would be done by Nehru going to north-western Ghana."

## Strong hold

Some reports say Dr. Nkrumah has a strong hold on the people of India and was warmly welcomed here. It is said that many events have been planned in Ghana which will cause a similar reaction to the one which greeted the democratic leader in India. The independent press here says there may be some incidents of violence and some popular demonstrations in the capital, Accra, in connection with the visit. It is said that the visit will be a landmark in the history of the country.

## CO-ORDINATION OF WAR ON DISEASE

RESOLUTIONS of 26 countries are in Geneva for a conference of the World Health Organization's Regional Committee for Africa which opened at the Geneva Palais des Nations in the presence of Dr. Pierre Denon, deputy director-general. The last World Health Assembly which met at Geneva in May, recommended an intensification of the WHO's programme of assistance to newly independent and emerging States, particularly in Africa.

## Kenya 'no' to invitation

Kenya has declined an invitation to attend a conference on malaria in London. The invitation was issued by the World Health Organization. The Kenyan government has decided not to attend because of the high cost of travel and the need to focus resources on local health services. The WHO representative in Kenya said the invitation was a friendly gesture but that the government's decision was based on practical considerations.

## Yaws campaign

The regional director's annual report for 1962 draws attention to the yaws problem which often afflicts the newly independent States. The report says that the WHO is assisting in the control of the disease through the use of penicillin. The WHO representative in Kenya said that the disease is a major health problem in many parts of Africa and that the WHO is working to help countries develop effective control programmes.

## Katangese mine kills Gburkas

MR. E. W. MATHU, the United Nations chief representative in Elisabethville yesterday said a strong protest to the Katangese authorities over the death of two Indian U.N. soldiers in a mine incident. Four other soldiers were injured in the same incident when a Gburka patrol set off mine north of Elisabethville.

The commander of the Indian U.N. brigade in the Katanga capital, Brig. Norrish, said a Press conference that the 13-man patrol was patrolling in normal land between the U.N. and Katangese lines. One corporal and a private were killed instantly while the other soldiers were wounded. Another soldier was seriously injured and two others slightly. The explosion occurred in thick bush about 800 yards from the Katangese Army checkpoint and two miles from the spot where Katangese soldiers died in a skirmish involving Gburkas on 12 days ago.

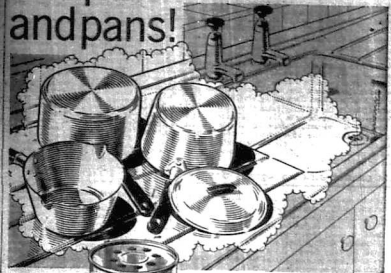

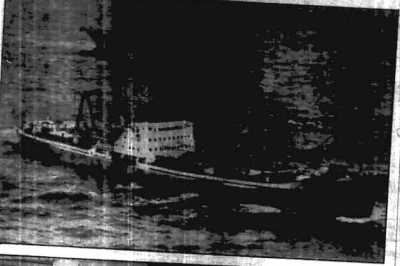
