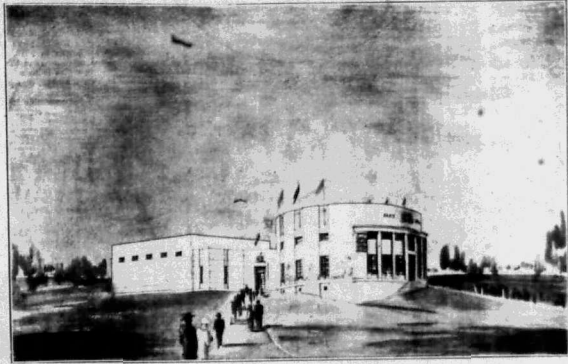

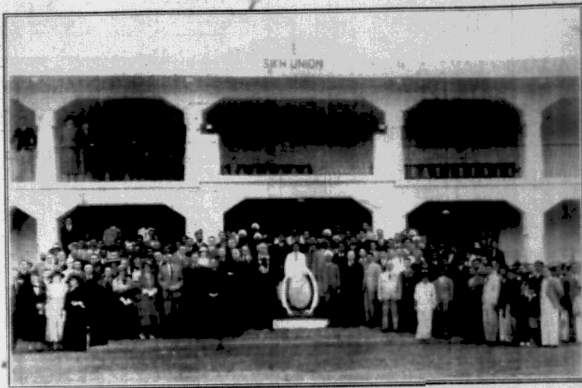

SECOND BIG BATTLE IN THE TEMBIEN

ITALIANS CLAIM A "SHATTERING VICTORY"

Hand-to-Hand Fighting

CRITICAL POSITION OF ABYSSINIAN FORCES

Home, February 26. The Italians have captured Ambalangi.

Home, February 29. A great battle has been raging ever down yesterday according to a communique which states that the Third Army Corps and an Eritrean Corps attacked Has Kassa's Forces in the Tembien from the North and South.

ENGULFING MOVEMENT

Other reports state that the Italians have begun a movement to encircle the forces of Has Kassa and Ras Seyoum. Two corps started to move from Aksum and Fincha are attempting to gain round the corners to both flanks.

HEAVY FIRE

A later communique says that Maschal thought reports that the second battle in the Tembien has taken place and that the situation of Has Kassa and Ras Seyoum's forces, caught piecemeal by the Italians, has become very critical indeed.

Rome, March 1. An official bulletin claims that the army of Has Kassa on the Eritrean front has been severely beaten and is breaking up.

It is reported in Rome, though the bulletin is without confirmation, that Has Kassa committed suicide after the defeat of his army.

Addis Ababa, March 1. A desperate battle is taking place along the river Rame about 20 miles west of the Anaito-Ambalangi range.

"FIERCE RESISTANCE"

According to official reports the Italians, advancing from the East, are encountering fierce resistance from the armies of Has Kassa and Ras Mung'istola.

It is reported that hundreds of Italians and Abyssinians perished in hand-to-hand fighting near Mung'istola, the fighting began the Italians bombarded the Abyssinian positions with mountain and field artillery, but several Abyssinian heavy charges rendered the employment of artillery impossible.

The latest reports indicate stalemate in this sector, but heavier fighting is reported to have begun in the Tembien.

"SHATTERING VICTORY"

Rome, March 2. It is officially announced that the second battle in the Tembien concluded with a shattering victory for the Italians against the armies of Ras Kassa and Ras Seyoum.

FEBRUARY RAINFALL - NAIROBI

In the Editor, "E.A. Standard," Nairobi, Kenya, 10th March 1936. I have the pleasure to inform you that the rainfall for the month of February 1936 was 1.18 inches, which is 0.18 inches below the normal for the month.

My average for February at this recording station is 2.24 inches over the month. On the other side of the mountain that we have had great rainfall since we had 5.00 inches in the month and a reference to the figures below will show that we had about twice as much rain as the normal for the month.
