DECLARED PAN SOUTH WEST AFRICA NOT TO BE PART OF UNION

UNANIMOUSLY and with acclamation the United Nations Assembly this week passed a resolution calling for a general reduction of armaments, with effective safeguard for those who are in possession of the regulation of the use of atomic energy. The Security Council has been charged with the task of working out for disarmament.

This was one of several decisions taken as the Assembly adjourned towards the closing stage of the session. It was agreed to accept the recommendation of a site in New York for a permanent home for the United Nations Organization and other decisions included the turning down of the South African claim for the incorporation of South-West Africa in the Union.

The passing of the resolution on armaments followed the adoption of the United Nations Declaration on Disarmament. 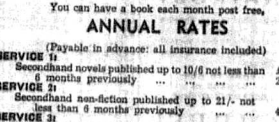

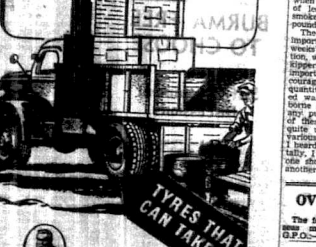

Southern Japan's Weekend Of Death And Terror

Worse Than 1923 Disaster

PEOPLE in the area near the South Coast of Japan have spent a weekend of terror as a result of earth tremors which began in the early hours of Saturday morning and brought with them tidal waves which, at a height of several feet, swept inland over the low-lying coast.

It is estimated so far that 686 Japanese have lost their lives and that 4,700 buildings have been destroyed. In the region of half a million people are reported to have been rendered homeless.

The most serious damage is in an area 100 miles long and from 50 to 60 miles wide, which includes the Island of Shikoku, and is in the British Commonwealth zone.

It is officially stated, however, that there have been no Allied casualties.

The first earthquake, which was of some intensity, was reported to have shaken Tokyo at 4.25 a.m. on Saturday morning.

It is reported that a tidal wave was reported along the coast of the island of Shikoku, and that it was 15 minutes after the earthquake.
