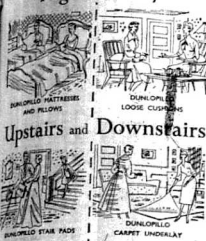

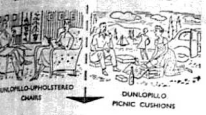

## HUMBLE EGG IN SAVOURY GUISES

WHAT a boon to the housewife is the humble egg. It can be dressed up in many fascinating guises and presented as a delicatessen to the most discerning of the many gourmets, especially when prepared in the following ways.

Occasionally one may come across a hard-boiled egg, one which has been boiled in the water, and which has been boiled in the water.

But let us consider the following:

### EGG CROQUETTES

Assuming you wish to make eight croquettes, the ingredients for this dish are: three hard-boiled eggs, one ounce of butter, one egg, one ounce of milk, salt and pepper, crumbs.

First chop the hard-boiled eggs, four and mix into a pulp, add the chopped egg, one ounce of salt and pepper, and stir well. Place on a wire mesh and form into small portions, set these into a cooking fat form with the raw egg, and fry them, remove, and fry to a golden-brown in hot fat.

### SCOTCH EGGS

For six traditional dishes you need two eggs, half a pound of minced meat, one ounce of tomatoes, salt and pepper to taste, egg and bread-crumbs and crostons of fried bread.

Hard-boil the eggs, then roll them in cold water, peel, and cut into small pieces, a little white. A few minutes will remove the shell, and dry them well with sausage meat, followed by egg and breadcrumbs.

Roll into shape, and fry them in hot fat, giving time for sausage meat to be well cooked.

### CURRIED EGGS

Here is a tasty and pleasant dish for four people. The ingredients consist of four hard-boiled eggs, one ounce of small apple, half an ounce of curry powder, half an ounce of fat, one ounce of milk, a dash of lemon juice, salt to taste, and crostons.

# UGANDA DENIES CLAIM OF CHEAPER THIKA POWER

## Suggestion for inquiry

STATEMENTS that power supplied to Kampala from Uganda would cost twice as much as the power from the projected new Ferkis hydro-electric scheme at Thika were denied by the Uganda Electricity Board yesterday.

The board announced that it would welcome an independent inquiry into the technical and financial value of the power from the proposed Ferkis scheme and provide the fullest information that would be "most willing" to be made as a result of a speech at Thika by the Kenya Minister for Industries and Commerce, Mr. Blundell, after his return from Nairobi in September last.

At the meeting a memorandum was presented showing that the cost of power would be saved if another site than was proposed and a 21,000 kw. transmission line was built from Nairobi to the site. This estimate allowed for a transmission line which would take more than 18 months to erect, but the offer to supply at the Seven Forks.

## Raiders kill cattle at Nanyuki

MAU MAU terrorists are believed to be responsible for the killing of three cattle and humans and two others at Rotherham Park, in the Nanyuki area, during a Saturday night.

The owner of the farm, Mr. Arnold Paine, told the East African Standard that the Mau Mau had been discovered early Sunday morning when they went to the hills below which is about two miles away from the farm, but that they were not seen until they were seen on the hills about 100 yards from the farm.
