

INQUIRY UPHOLDS CHARGE AGAINST HOLA COMMANDANT

Dereliction of duty in executing Cowan plan substantiated

Allegations of gross dereliction of duty by Michael Gordon, commandant of the Nova Scotia militia, have been held by a committee of inquiry to be substantiated.

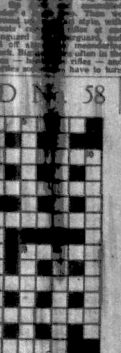

U.S. Minister to leave next week

FOREIGN Ministers of the Big Four Powers yesterday began at Geneva a final attempt to break their deadlock in Berlin, after the United States representative, Mr. Herter, had said he wanted the conference to end on Wednesday, "with or without agreement".

In Washington President Eisenhower said there had not been any progress so far at the Geneva Foreign Ministers meeting which would justify calling a meeting of Heads of Government.

The Foreign Ministers had run into big difficulties, he added, and the complex international problems which the maintenance of peace demanded were more amenable to discussion by the Heads of Governments.

In Geneva Mr. Herter told the Soviet Foreign Minister, Mr. Gromyko, that he wanted to leave next Thursday for the Western Hemisphere. Foreign Ministers meeting in Geneva, President Eisenhower confirmed that he wanted Mr. Herter personally to attend this meeting, which is being held in the city of Geneva.

More valuable than Council debates, Lord James says

It might be more valuable for the child who was growing up to be a citizen of a democracy to learn something "modern" subject like Greek than to listen to debates in the Legislative Council.

Lord James of Rubens, High Master of Manchester Grammar School, said this yesterday on the first day of an educational seminar, organised by the Kenya Teachers' Union and held at the Duke of Gloucester School, Nairobi.

Speaking on "Leadership, Democracy and Education", Lord James said he did not reject the idea of experimentation in teaching children about the meaning and practice of democracy. A democratic approach was fundamentally an attitude of mind rather than possession of knowledge.

Dealing with examinations, he stressed that the examination must never be a master, but a tool. It was not an end in itself. Examinations stimulated a child and gave him something to aim at. The system was necessary because it was a diagnosis of the child's ability.

Pressure needed to set up schools

Wrongly used, however, examinations could give the wrong idea of what education was—that it was merely an accumulation of facts which could be mentally regurgitated at a given time.

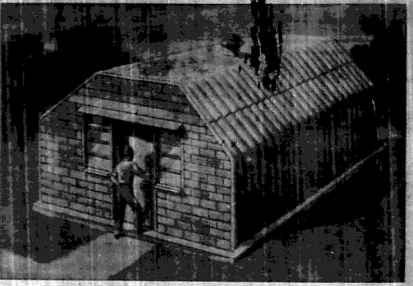
