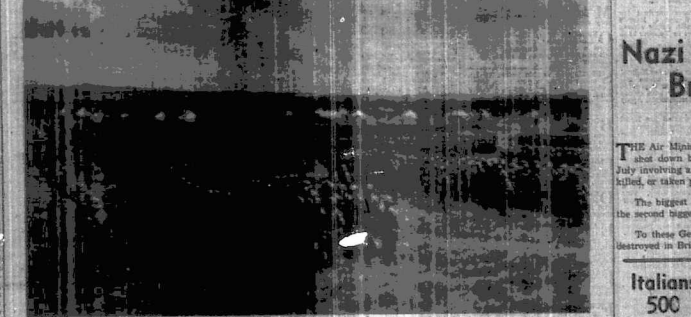

The effects of the war on the structure of industry and trade are bound to be far-reaching and fundamental (transfers the Financial Times, London, as an article headed "Men, Money and Machines"). Changes already envisaged range from:

1. The closing of large-scale manufacturing industries into big plants at one end in consequence to control and regularize personal expenditures at the other; it has to be recognized that the present industrial evolution is going through a phase which may bring a result very different from the most advanced economies.

2. The introduction of new machinery, raised up by the huge efforts. The clear working now being required between industry and allied trade, in connection with the formation of export groups, points to the elimination of the competitive element in favour of large-scale operation even to the extent of a national unit of industry.

3. The financial effect: Integration in the top level industry is undoubtedly linked with the financial effort which will involve ever more careful handling if the best results are to be obtained. The production of the vast sums necessary for the prosecution of modern armaments is a task which will be entirely new dimensions because of the definite increase in the original estimate of £2,000 millions a year for expenditure on armaments since the outbreak of the war.

X-Ray for Tobacco

Called the "X-ray plant," a new tobacco plant which is harder and less ready to grow than any hitherto produced has been developed by the University of California by means of X-ray treatment, states the London correspondent of The Star (Johannesburg).

It is being given experimental treatment in the United States, Peru and Australia, according to the correspondent of The British Daily News at Berkeley, California.

Having more than the ordinary number of leaves and no sucker growth and growing more slowly than the normal plant, it promises a more abundant yield per plant at lower production costs, and apparently it is adaptable to regions which have a late frost. Dr. Hesperwood, speed. Director of the University's botanical gardens, explained that commercial importance has still to be established, but this, after several experiments it promises well.
