Mutual Sacrifices It is noticeable that the schemes which the Government of Kenya has introduced for the control of the marketing of coffee will give rise to criticism. There is already been criticism of it in some quarters, mainly those associated with the commercial side of the industry, and it seems to arise from the belief that the scheme was hastily imposed, inadequately thought out, and applied before there was a reasonable opportunity afforded to all concerned to appreciate the points. There is also some criticism that interested parties in Uganda and Tanganyika may object to the extension of the control to their produce.

Board and the trade interests leave us with the impression that the charge of hasty decision is not unjustified, and that the Kenya Government was prepared by the instance of the Supply Board and the Coffee Board authorities to assume too readily that the planters and commercial interests were agreed in favour of a control scheme of local import control on the advice of the Executive Council, and the decision having been announced, the Kenya Government was probably found it difficult to withdraw from the position in which it had placed itself. It is well to remember that important sections of the trade have long been regarded as the policy of the Coffee Board in respect of marketing and export of coffee almost every proposal as a step in an attempt to create for the Coffee Board a dictatorial body like the Kenya Farmers' Association. In this new proposal these critics will doubtless be concerned to protect their freedom and interests, and feared that the special markets, so laboriously built up, would be destroyed at one stroke by a Government control not fully acquainted with all the ramifications and complications of finely balanced marketing machinery. There was some reason to believe that the planters did not fully understand what was being proposed and that the introduction of the control would be obscured by much confusion due in part to inadequate explanation and discussion, and certainly to undue haste.

The conditions of war enable us to accept many situations in which a normal trader would decline to acquire but in dealing with commerce and industry, and particularly in so important and difficult a field as coffee, it is of the greatest importance that there should be patient and comprehensive investigation and planning on lines which bring as many interests as possible voluntarily into such a scheme. What is itself is certainly an adequate excuse for unrestrained dictation by a temporary authority. There is a tendency in this country for these authorities to imagine that because there is a war they are entitled to disregard all the actual rules, in their treatment of private interests and that attitude of mind will have to be checked. Bodies such as the Supply Board have been set up to further the public interest by methods which command the respect of the people; they are not in any sense or under any circumstances expected or intended to act as dictators, major or minor.

But though the coffee question was not very far advanced when the scheme was first introduced, the approach has left more than a little resentment against authority, and it is not unlikely that the scheme will ultimately work broadly to the benefit of the industry and the country, though they are merely a war-time makeshift. 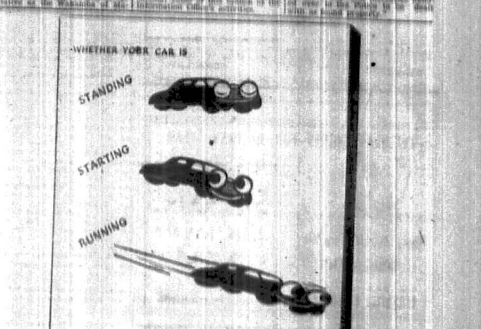
