THE STORY OF THE KENYA FARMERS' ASSOCIATION

By Eric Bayles

The Kenya Farmers' Association is a farmers' co-operative run by farmers for farmers.

THE Kenya Farmers' Association (Co-operative) Ltd., of which it is popularly called, the K.F.A., is a co-operative association of European farmers with branches in all main farming areas of Kenya and in the Northern Provinces and Southern Highlands of Tanganyika.

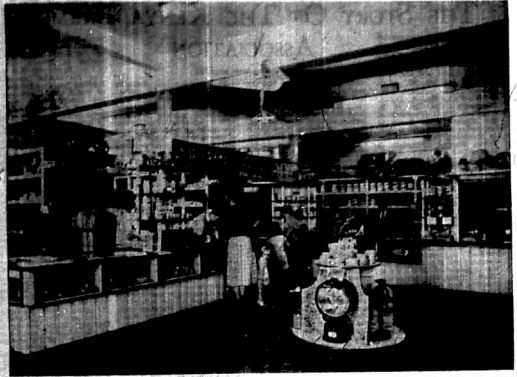
The first step was to market European crops in the most advantageous manner and the second to provide necessary services such as fertilizers, tools, etc. The K.F.A. was formed in 1952, the Association representing the most general representation of its kind in East Africa. At the outbreak of World War II it was the only co-operative which Government would allow for the general

representative of a rapidly growing area in East Africa and for several months the Association was responsible for the great bulk of the Army's food supplies.

The Association's getdown in the Lake Industrial Area, Nairobi, has a 600-foot railway siding and is one of the finest in East Africa. Railway siding at 4.5 miles. Railway siding at 4.5 miles. Railway siding at 4.5 miles.

The K.F.A. is now 10 years old but its roots really go back a lot further. The co-operative marketing movement began to take shape in the latter part of 1917 when a number of farmers in the Lower Rift formed what was called the Maize Growers' Association to deal more systematically with a crop the bulk of which was consumed locally. European settlement increased considerably after the war and P.F.A. marketing of crops which now included a wide range of products.

the turnover was in the region of £2,000,000, the authorized capital was £1,250,000 of which about £800,000 was paid up, and it owned over 100,000 worth of land, buildings and machinery. The management of the capital was £200,000 of which £150,000 had been loaned.

Today the Association has 14 branches—at Eldoret, Ilmorog, British Somaliland, Kisumu, Molo, Thambani, P.O. 11, Nairobi, Nakuru, Kericho, Naivasha, Arusha, and Mogadishu. It has 200,000 members and 200,000 acres of land. It has 125 branches in Kenya and 125 branches in Tanganyika in addition to about 150 African laborers. It has expanded far beyond the expectations of its originators. For two or three years in the late 1940s it was a leading market for general marketing of a wide range of products in a market of £1,000,000 in 1949. But the following year, through general depression, production and a decision to drop general trading, the accounts reflected a surplus of over £200,000.

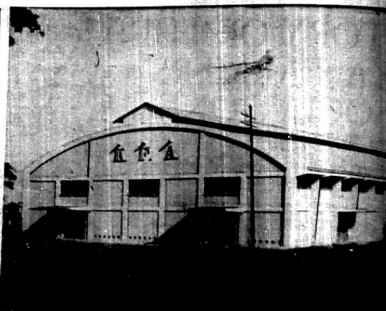

The Men At The Top Of The K. F. A.

THE present chairman of the Board of Directors, Captain L. A. Spiers, M.C., of Nyiro, assumed the duties of chairman in mid-1953 owing to the ill-health of the previous chairman, Mr. James Mackay.

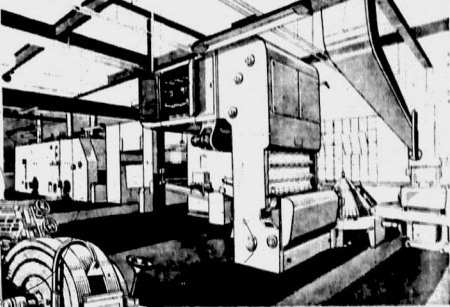

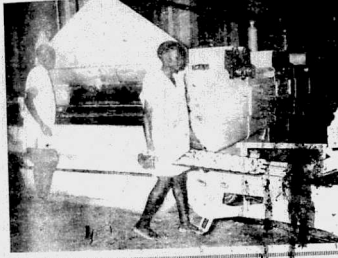
