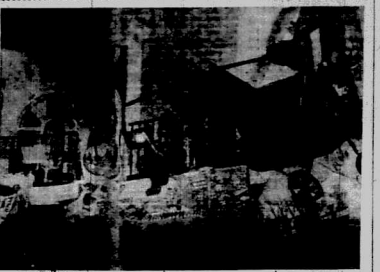

Staff problems in postal services

CURB ON TRAINED MEN FROM U.K.

DIFFICULTIES encountered in attracting trained staff from outside Kenya are mentioned by the Postmaster-General, Mr. R. E. Porter, when he outlined the expansion East Africa's telecommunications services to Nairobi Chamber of Commerce.

He said the Post Office could absorb local expansion, but applications were few, and the training course was full. His real requirement was fully trained technical staff from Britain, but the British Post Office was not prepared to set-up its development programme and was restricting the number of engineers allowed to go to colonial territories.

Mr. Gorman said there had been no spectacular development on the postal side of the service. The emphasis had been on security and reliability.

He considered that for many years it would be necessary to rely on mobile transport for postal services. There was little likelihood of development of a mail van transport between the two main centres.

In reply to questions, Mr. Gorman said that the sorting of incoming mail at Nairobi could be completed by 3 a.m. each day. But he pointed out that during the first 17 days of each month the post office worked on an eight-hour shift.

Very considerable work was done on postal services had to be done in the past few years, rapidly expanding telephone network, Mr. Gorman said.

More telephones
In the past few years the number of telephones in East Africa had increased from 18,000 to about 42,000. The telephone service was still running at a loss and was not expected to be self-supporting for at least another five years.

75-ton crane tested for rail service

Tests have taken place in the Nairobi locomotive sheds with a 75-ton steam locomotive crane (shown) which will be used for re-rolling locomotives, carriages and wagons involved in accidents.

The largest of its type in operation on a metric gauge railway, including the water and fuel tank, is the first of the two to be placed in service on the Kenya and Uganda sections of East African Railways.

The crane has been designed by the latest 75-ton locomotive and high-capacity wagon, and is required to reconstruct the locomotive.

100 feet long
In working under the crane, 161 tons, and the total length, including the water and fuel tank, is 100 feet. The crane is working as a power unit of 120 hp. The crane is powered by electric lighting is provided for night operation.

A main and an auxiliary boiler allow for maximum load of 75 tons at 15 feet radius and 100 feet for the engine, a lifting outstagger in operation. The crane is capable of carrying a load of 4½ tons at 200 feet.

Delivery of the second crane was expected shortly, and within the two in service, the restoration of the reconstruction in the field will be greatly facilitated.

EDGAR FAURE, Prime Minister of France, is the youngest and least powerful of the "Big Four" at Geneva. But by way of compensation, he will almost certainly have by far the highest amount of work done by psychologists and intelligence specialists. Mr. Faure, who has worked with the phenomenon of the rise from the anonymous to the famous, has overworked legal procedure in the behavior of "puffery" of his doctrine, or beliefs, but none of them doubt they have had the unwilling assistance of some of the intelligence of the post-war world. Mr. Faure's lack of experience has been offset by two other advantages: a rapid recall of memory and a quite astonishing gift for negotiation and conciliation, doubtless developed by his long tenure, which he has improved with brilliant results in maintaining peace and order in his own beliefs.

EISENHOWER: A Talent for Making Complex Simple

Of the four men at the summit, Dwight Eisenhower, the President of the United States, is the most powerful and, to many, the most mysterious. He is powerful, not merely because he represents the wealth of the world, but because he is the only leader of his country who has been charged with full and sole executive responsibility and deeply powerful because of his great personal prestige in his own country. He is, however, a failure because, although a brilliant tactician in the months following his arrival in office in January 1953, year after year he has been unable to decide whether he is a great or merely a lucky man, a man of peace and good luck and fortune. He is neither a brilliant tactician nor a brilliant strategist as Franklin Roosevelt was, nor a man of great application like Truman, nor a man of a simple talent for large questions and concentration in the manner of Winston Churchill, nor the best method of handling a crisis as John F. Kennedy or Dwight D. Eisenhower. He is a man who has tried to make his mind too large for his own good, to apply the same to all situations.
