Red Cross work 'way to restore peace in Kenya'

LADY MARY BARING'S APPEAL

A CALL to Red Cross members to meet with wisdom, courage, patience and perseverance the recent raid on Nairobi was made by Lady Mary Baring in her presidential address to the annual meeting in Nairobi of the Kenya branch of the Red Cross.

It was the duty of the Red Cross to fight any kind of racialism, she said, and the efforts to be taken to it. The owners of the land must be asked if they will do their duty.

If they will not do so, then the article and undemanded materials will be made available.

An amendment to the principles of the Red Cross was proposed to require that funds from privately owned and controlled land should be given to the recovery from the flood.

The proposal was supported by the Government and approved by the council.

When the Red Cross was established, the public is to be removed from the control of funds to the council's site.
