Criticism omitted in new U.N. report

NO RECOMMENDATIONS ON TIME-TABLE

A REPORT on Tanganyika published by the Drafting Committee of the United Nations Trusteeship Council is taken in London to be a vindication of the British Government's administration of the East African territory.

The report, drawn up by representatives of Australia, Belgium, China and Haiti, does not contain any direct criticism of the region's political and social progress. It makes no recommendations within a time-table for the achievement of self-government within a period of five years.

It refers to the multi-racial society which the British administration has established in Tanganyika. It acknowledges that next month it is intended to establish an enlarged and reorganised Legislative Council and that it is well within the five-year period envisaged.

The report also recognises that while the principle of parity between the two population groups, with equal representation for each, has been adopted with the idea that it shall function for some time, it is basically transitional.

The Drafting Committee also recommends that the new Legislative Council be established on a parity basis with the African population, and that it should be empowered to demand for democratic arrangements appropriate voting qualifications.

The report has to go before the Council for approval. It is expected that the Council will approve the report in its present form.

The United Nations Trusteeship Council, which is the body responsible for the administration of Tanganyika, has today issued its report on the territory.

The report is a study of the progress made since the territory was placed under the trusteeship of the United Nations in 1948. It is the first of a series of reports which will be issued at intervals of five years.

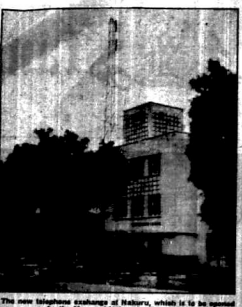
EAST AFRICAN RAIL SERVICE IMPROVED

Scotland will take place on the same grounds on April 4.

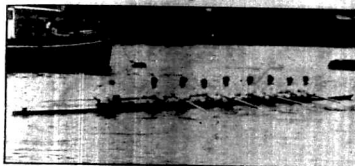

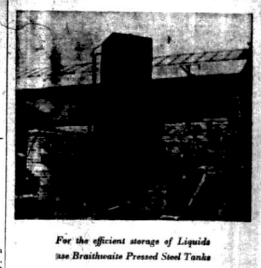

Survey work begins on water scheme

SUPPLY FOR DAR ES SALAAM
INVESTIGATION, survey and design work has begun on the scheme to take a domestic supply of water from the Ruvu River to Dar es Salaam. The scheme aims to supply about 2,000,000 gallons a day in the first stage, and will be displaced at stages, as the demand for water rises, until it is supplying 7,000,000 gallons a day.

It is expected that the cost of the first stage of the scheme will be about £100,000. The scheme will be financed by the Government and the Dar es Salaam Corporation. The scheme will be completed in 1942.

MODEL FARMS FOR AFRICANS IN KWALE
Three to six acre plots at Mtwara, Kilimo and Kibungwe, are each to be handed over to a selected individual farmer for the purpose of demonstrating to other Africans the advantages of modern farming. The Government's advice and assistance will be given to each of the three holdings which will be laid out in each of the three areas.

The concrete reservoir, with a capacity of 2,000,000 gallons, will be sited about nine miles from Dar es Salaam, and the water supply will gravitate from it to five service tanks. The tanks at Oberehan Hill and Uthungu will serve the town by gravity.

The first stage of the scheme will mean the laying of 45 miles of steel pipe, ranging in diameter from 18 to 24 in. The present daily supply of Dar es Salaam from the Ruvu is 1,000,000 gallons, which is steadily as the town develops.

DEPOSITS OF RADIO-ACTIVE COAL FOUND IN NYASALAND

A thin seam of radio-active coal, with a uranium-oxide content of 73 per cent, has been discovered in Nyasaland. 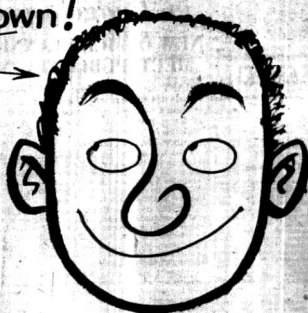

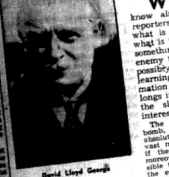

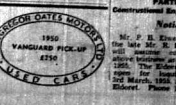

City Council to establish junk centre

AS part of its drive to tidy up Nairobi, the City Council has decided to establish a junk centre. At its meeting on Thursday the council resolved, subject to the approval of the Finance Committee, to establish a junk centre and to invite the junk men living around the city to be taken there. The council will then be charged daily duty if they wish to receive any article and undamaged materials will be sold.

An amendment to the Municipal Ordinance to permit the council to receive from private citizens and from land, and to provide for the recovery from the junk men of the junk that was recommended by the Municipal Council has been approved by the council.

When the reception centre is established, the public is to be invited to contribute to the burning accumulations of junk to the council's site.

Ban on keeping of dangerous dogs
