

LOW-COST HOUSING PLAN FOR SALISBURY

Move to overcome shortage

IOW-COST housing schemes are being planned by the Salisbury City Council in an attempt to overcome the city's acute housing shortage. The City Valuator and Estate Manager, Mr. D. Bledsoe, said that the council has already developed one estate and has several other projects in view.

Mr. Bledsoe said that the contractor was building 20 houses at Lower Hillside which would be completed by the end of the year. They would have a built-in garage and would include single and double garages, a house and a semi-detached house.

Mr. Bledsoe said he would like to see the council build 100 houses and would keep six to be built in the next year.

Mr. Bledsoe added that the Housing Committee would approve the next meeting of the council for the development of another estate at Hillside by a satisfactory form of contract.

Many other projects are being planned for the city. A large South African construction company had recently made inquiries about starting a housing estate in Hillside. The council's housing committee had been in the last 18 months.



Minister estimates cost of European and Asian needs

At least £8,000,000 is needed to solve the European and Asian housing problem in Kenya, the Housing Minister estimates in a Legislative Council. 

"Despicable methods" used by poachers in trapping and snaring wild animals were condemned on Wednesday by Mr. M. Cowie, Director of the Royal National Parks and a Government Nominated Member of Legislative Council.

Mr. Cowie was speaking in the House on the vote for the Ministry of Forest Development, Game and Fisheries. He said there was evidence of poachers in game reserves, "poachers" gangs and of black market trading in game trophies. There was a considerable traffic in the country in snaring birds, small rodents and other creatures. "It was easy to say to me, 'I have been certain people who found it profitable'."

He stated: "We have the privileged position of being hunted, but I doubt if that position ever had a mandate deliberately to destroy the lesser creature, Mr. Blunt told the House that officers of the Game Department had been instructed, when bringing prosecutions, to notify magistrates that poaching was a prevalent crime in the hope that sentences might be increased. 

Quarter Centenary Of The Nile Bridge

It was 25 years ago that history was made in East Africa with an ascent upon Uganda, for it was in January, 1931, that the first train crossed over the Nile Bridge and upon the next day that regular services were to start between Jinja and Kampala.

Remembrance of the Nile Bridge is taken for granted. The fact that it is possible to travel the 67 1/2 miles from Kampala to Mombasa by rail without interruption is a fact which a moment's thought.

Yet it is surprising that until 1931, Kampala was not, in fact, in direct rail communication with the Indian Ocean, for there was the White Nile, and the White Nile had not been developed.

By 1911, railway development in East Africa was well advanced. It is surprising, therefore, that a bridge had not been built across the Nile long before this date. All the more so since a new scheme has already been formulated at Kinross.

The need for direct communication with Kampala was ever on the increase for economic reasons. Kampala, before the building of the bridge, could only be reached from the railroads at Jinja. The lake steamer with all the attendant disadvantages of loading and unloading, and there were complaints about the congestion of traffic at the Lake port. There had virtually been no transportation to Kampala from the Lake port since the Lake steamer was destroyed in 1911. It was in 1927 that Mr. Pellier (later to become Sir Christian Pellier), General Manager of the Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours Administration, realised the importance of a link between Kampala and Jinja, later Mr. Pellier, after Sir Charles Johnston, the first Controller of the railway, under the supervision of Mr. J. J. Birchall, C.B.E., the Resident Commissioner of the Kenya and Uganda Railways Administration, had the Nile Bridge built. The Nile Bridge was the first link between Jinja and Kampala which was a direct line, straight the necessity of building a line to Kampala as part of the railway system. It was realised that the Nile-Kampala route was the only direct communication between the two cities, the connection from Jinja to Kampala was the most important step in railway development in the Kenya

Thereafter, it is believed, the competent crew, who kept in readiness in the meantime, were able to pick up the bridge with three cables. The work for the bridge had been made by Messrs. J. and W. McCallan, at Chikwa Works, Glasgow.
