A SPECTACULAR earthwork movement is being engineered at Kipevu on the site of the newly planned deep water quays, where Kipevu Hill is being chopped in two.

When the project is finished, 100,000 cubic feet of earth will be used as fill for the new quays and other projects.

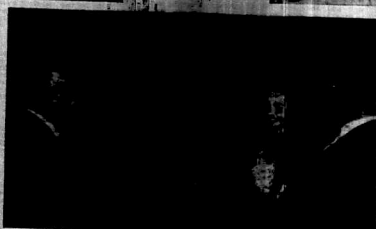

BRITAIN invested yesterday that she is working on the problems of hydrogen energy producing industrial power.

The investigations have been going on since the Atomic Energy Research Authority (A.E.R.A.) was set up in 1946. The work was "concentrated on the development of a new type of reactor which would produce a very high temperature, but not too hot to be used in the production of electricity."

VESEL ABANDONED AS LIST INCREASES

An Atlantic liner sank yesterday after colliding with another liner in thick fog and darkness 190 miles from New York. She went down a few hours after all her 1,234 passengers and 500 crew had been saved by vessels which hurried to the scene in the most dramatic rescue of modern times.

The stricken vessel was the Andrea Doria, 29,100 tons, one of Italy's largest liners. After the collision she listed so badly that she was unable to use her own lifeboats and sent out urgent SOS calls.

The other vessel in the collision, the Swedish liner Stockholm, 12,600 tons, had her bows stove in and her No. 1 hold flooded. Three on board were killed, and a number who were injured were flown by New York City helicopter which landed on her deck. Although crippled, she joined in the rescue of the Andrea Doria's passengers.

Treasury note on currency dealings

NOTES on the law governing the use of foreign currency in Kenya are to be circulated by the Treasury to banks, airlines, shipping agents, motor-tourists, travel agents and money changers in the colony. The main points in the regulations are:—(1) The holder—one of the seven categories of persons mentioned in the regulations—is to be permitted to undertake transactions in foreign currency with the consent of the Minister for Finance and Development.

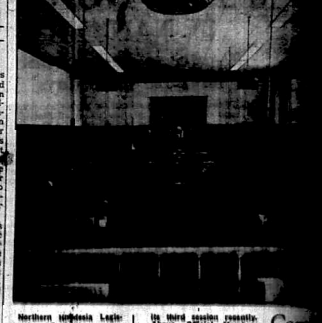

CRUISING ON AN INLAND SEA

A TRAVELLING holiday without contraptions or boats was what I was after and East Africa has few holidays of this kind to offer—except Lake Victoria. This was behind my realisation of a Lake trip, little realising what an interesting-paced journey it would be.

Probably few who have not visited the steamer trip around the lake have seen the second largest sheet of fresh water in the world, not to mention the largest in East Africa. The steamer trip is just what a pleasant and different holiday they desire.

Train to Kisumu

The train trip from Nairobi to Kisumu gets one there without clouds of dust, or there is the alternative route to the Lake via Kampala and Port Bell. Nairobi, however, is more convenient, being the main base for the Lake steamers, and my steamer was waiting at the station for me. The train normally makes the trip in 12 hours, but the 28 first-class passengers are accommodated on the main deck in the small two-room cabin. For my trip it was the Uganda which first started its steamer service on the lake in 1914, but it is still in good shape although things can get pretty rough on this inland sea when the southerly gales are blowing.

Knowledge of history by the way can be quite useful when one does a trip like the one on the waters of Lake Victoria. Enjoying the comforts supplied on the steamer, nearly five centuries of events a day or two just over the shore of the lake was very different from what it is today. Great stretches of water was not even covered in the White Man or the Western world and those living by its shores simply spoke of it as "stretching to the end of the world".

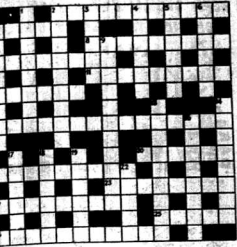

COMPANIES URGED TO REGISTER SERVANTS

Select Committee reports to Council

FE BAN PROPOSED FOR FORMER CRIMINALS

IMPULSORY and selective registration of domestic servants in Kenya, and the issue of certificates which will have to be produced on seeking employment, is recommended by a Select Committee which the Legislative Council appointed last December to consider and report on the domestic service situation.

The committee, which presented its report to the Legislative Council this week, considered any possibility of a crime of violence, a sexual offence or serious offence for being a member of a prohibited, subversive or terrorist organisation from being registered as a domestic servant.

On the question of whether one document only should be provided both for identification and registration, members were divided. It was finally agreed that purposes of identification, a person could carry only his domestic service registration document—or, alternatively, this and the normal identity certificate.

The committee feels that establishment of a wage scale for mutual confidence between employer and servant should be introduced on a system of registration which that industrial control which had given long and useful service.

It should be the alteration of existing legislation—which provides for registration on a voluntary basis—and to ensure that the "out card" system should be maintained more fully than it is. It agreed that employers should be able to identify domestic servants readily, and considered that there is a case for making registration certificates contain photographs.

The report begins by recalling that, to obtain the widest possible expression of public opinion, a questionnaire survey was prepared and a Press committee was set up to receive and discuss the views of members of the public and from various primary organizations.

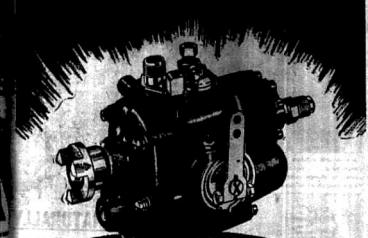

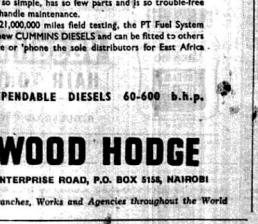
