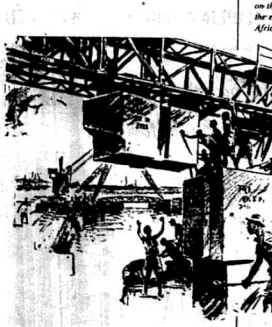

Director proposal for the Serengeti Park PRESERVATION TALKS

JOINT discussions have taken place between the Board of Trustees of the National Parks and the management board of the Serengeti National Park on various important problems concerning the preservation of the natural features of the Serengeti Park without encroaching on the rights of those people who have had such rights established by law.

The discussion took place a few days ago and the present board joined the trustees during a visit to the Serengeti area of the park. It was agreed that the board would undertake by the way of management and to some extent by the trustees would be more concerned with the day-to-day management of the park and the Board of Trustees consisting of the Government, the Director of National Parks and the Director of the Serengeti Park, would be put into effect it might be necessary to continue to be responsible to the Government.

Essential points

One essential point raised at the talks and subsequently considered at a formal meeting of the board, were as follows:—

The experience of the past three years has shown the inadequacy of the National Parks Ordinance and it was agreed that it should be replaced as soon as possible by a comprehensive ordinance that would cover the entire area of the park and would give the trustees the right to make such decisions as might be necessary in the event of a recent development in the park which was not permitted.

Although reports from other countries have indicated that no final solution has yet been found to the difficulties arising from the continued presence of human inhabitants and domestic stock in national parks, it was agreed that in the case of the Serengeti National Park these difficulties would be solved by the following:

Full cooperation

It was agreed that full cooperation should be obtained from all classes of people who live in the area of the park and those persons having rights to the land in the park and those who are engaged in agriculture, stock raising, etc. It was emphasized, must confine their activities to their normal occupation in an uncompromising manner.

HYDRO-ELECTRIC SCHEME ON TANA RIVER

ALMOST in the middle of the Mau Mau trouble an area a new £1,000,000 hydro-electric scheme is taking shape which, when complete, will supply Nairobi with one-third more electric power.

Working on the scheme are 1,100 Kikuyu labourers and a few Africans from other tribes, supervised by a number of European engineers. Although construction is going on right in the Mau Mau area, there is no trouble from terrorist activities. These Kichwasi are working well on a development scheme which will bring rapidly increasing power to Nairobi's expanding industries.

This is the second phase of an enormous scheme costing altogether about £1,300,000. The first and smaller phase has already been completed near Fort Hall thanks to the splendid co-operation of Chief Wanji after whom it has been named.

In the completed scheme water from two rivers flowing down from the Aberdares, the Mathura and the Maragua, have been harnessed to drive two 2,500-h.p. vertical turbines of the Wapiti powerstation, a few miles to the south-east of Fort Hall.

From the Mathura River barrage a 81-foot tunnel drives for almost four miles through the solid phonolite hillsides, passing right under the Caribou museum, before the water out with a 360-foot drop to the Wanji station. This is supplemented by a conduit canal, leading the waters of the Maragua to the same station.

Much of the Wanji scheme was completed before the outbreak of Mau Mau terrorism brought Emergency conditions to the part of Kenya.

But the second project, the Low Tana Scheme, only began when terrorism was in full spate and in spite of the difficulties is proceeding according to plan.

Although the tunnel for the second scheme is shorter, it is a much more ambitious undertaking. A tunnel built to a finished diameter of 11 feet will carry the waters of the Low Tana through a distance of 2,000 yards to drive two 4,000 h.p. vertical turbo-alternators.

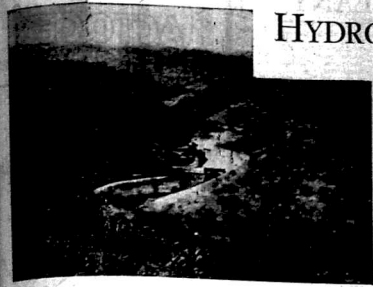
The power station to house the generating equipment is, in actual fact, an extension of a much smaller plant situated in 1921.

The Low Tana Scheme should begin feeding Nairobi with the full capacity of 6,000 kilowatts about the middle of 1953. It is at present at the stage, when the barrage across the river is being built. It is a concrete structure, 1,200 feet long, with a temporary diversion of the river. It will provide a storage sufficient to balance the operating period of the station.

Meanwhile the 2,000-ft tunnel is being blasted through the rock and lined with concrete. The contracting method used is similar to that developed on the much larger Woodhead Tunnel for British Railways through the Pennines. Engineers with experience of great schemes are now supervising the work in Kenya.

Cableways is planned on the Low Tana to carry specially constructed mobile gantries. Steel piping will carry the water from the surge chamber out through the portal and down a 20-foot fall to the power house at the edge of the Tana River.

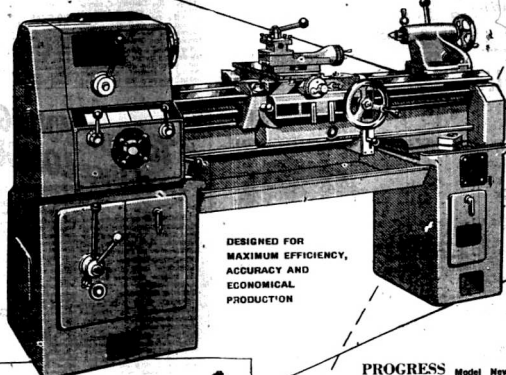

'MOGAMBO' COMES TO THE PLAYHOUSE

EAST AFRICA has become so much the Hollywood of this Continent in post-war years that it would no longer be original to say of Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer's *Mogambo*, which begins a three-week run at the Playhouse on Sunday, that it is "East Africa's own film."

Nevertheless, Nairobi, in particular, had such close contact with the stars—Ava Gardner, Clark Gable and Grace Kelly—while they were here, and with other members of the unit, living in our own New Stanley Hotel, that there will be few who will not be curious as to the result of their work. Do you remember that the 100-ton hammers at Entebbe Airport was transformed into a fully equipped film studio for the making of this picture? Every conceivable prop necessary for the film was made on the spot.

There was camera equipment ranging from platforms of 20 heights, coloured lights and multi-bulb "play" units, whistles, batteries, needles and ammunition.

"Anything that anyone could possibly use has to be taken along," explained Mr. Don Vash, the property master, at the time.

Stanley Goldsmith, the production manager, who preceded the rest of the company, arrived by six months, and, over the next few weeks, sent weeks mapping out the route, 10,000 miles of territory which turned out to be the largest safari area ever seen and during the four-month trip a group of 175 white people and 250 African carried enough equipment and paraphernalia to make them a self-sufficient little city.

Canvas town

A TOTAL of 80 vehicles, including lorries, hunting jeeps and even a refrigerator van, the latter for the highly sensitive Technicolor film, were used to transport this small army.

An estimated 500,000 yards of canvas went into the more than 200 tents that had to be set up at the safari camps and most of these had to be filled with small iron rods as well as table stands and canvas bath tubs.

Luxury amenities at the camp at Kagera River, Tanganyika, some 40 miles west of Lake Victoria, included a beauty parlour, an operation station which was in constant communication with hospitals in Nairobi, and a cinema.

The camp had its own electrical system.

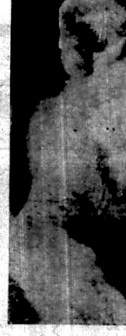
